What are we doing?

In March, we will be carrying out routine maintenance and safety inspections on the temporary bridge over the A361 near Chipping Warden, for one night. This bridge has significantly reduced our impact on the local road network, providing a safe route for our heavy plant to cross the A361 without interfering with highway traffic.

Following this, over several weekends, we will be working in the roadside verges as part of our preparations for the realignment of the A361 over the Chipping Warden green tunnel. To carry out this work safely, single lane traffic management will be in operation.

Work on the A361 realignment will continue throughout 2025 and some additional traffic management will be required later this year.

When will these works take place?

Road closure: overnight from 8.30pm Friday 14 March to 5.30am Saturday 15 March 2025.

UPDATE: Traffic lights: weekends from 8pm on Friday evenings until 6pm on Sundays. From 14 March until 12 May 2025.

This work is subject to approvals from the local authority and the dates of the work may change.




