

# Installation of monitoring equipment behind Conway Crescent, Perivale

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

## What we are doing

We will be installing monitoring equipment on the bridge piers behind Conway Crescent, Perivale. The work will take place one evening during the week from 31 March to 4 April 2025. The work is currently planned to take place on **Thursday 3 April 2025**.

The work will take place between 10pm and midnight when there are fewer trains using the Network Rail lines.

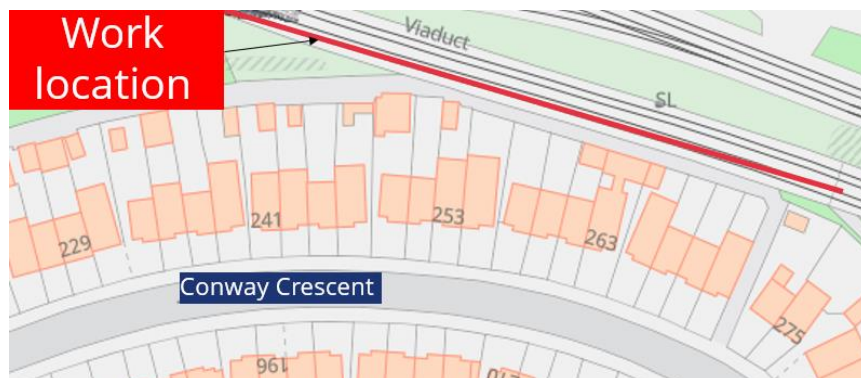
The monitoring equipment will allow us to monitor any ground movement before, during and after our tunnelling works.

We will set up scaffolding and use handheld drills to install the monitoring equipment. The equipment will remain in place for around two years before being removed.

## How this may impact you

You may notice workers in the area and some noise from handheld drills for a short time.

The area where the work will take place is shown on the map below. We are sorry for any inconvenience this work may cause.
