Notification

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

The new high-speed railway will pass under the A45 Coventry Road as it approaches the new Interchange station being built in Solihull. To enable HS2 to pass under the A45, a new overbridge will be constructed which will carry the eastbound and westbound carriageways and its two adjoining slip roads known as East Way and Service Road.

The A45 Coventry Road Overbridge will be constructed in phases. The first phase of construction is to complete the two slip road bridges and connect these to the existing slip roads, before traffic can be switch onto the new bridges and road realignments.

To undertake these works safely we will need to place overnight closures on the A45 Coventry Road eastbound carriageway and a one-week closure of the East Way slip road.

A45 eastbound overnight closures

A45 Coventry Road eastbound carriageway closure, between M42 junction 6 and Stonebridge roundabout, to install a safety barrier:

 Each night from 9pm to 6am on Saturday 22 March 2025 and Sunday 23 March 2025

Following these closures a single lane closure will remain in place on the A45 eastbound carriageway to provide our workforce with a safe working area.

East Way slip-road one week closure

The East Way slip road will be closed from **8am on Monday 24 March** to **6am on Monday 31 March 2025**

Duration of works

Overnight closures of the A45 eastbound carriageway on:

Saturday 22 March 2025 9pm to 6am Sunday 23 March 2025 9pm to 6am

Full one week closure of the East Way slip road between:

8am on Monday 24 March to 6am on Monday 31 March 2025.

What to expect

Signed diversion routes for each closure

Delay to journey time following diversion – Allow 10 minutes.

Low level noise from our work.

These works are subject to consent.



A45 Coventry Road eastbound overnight closure diversion route – 22 and 23 March 2025

Traffic wishing to join the A45 Coventry Road eastbound carriageway via the M42 junction 6 round-about will follow the fully signed diversion route onto the A45 Coventry Road westbound carriageway towards B4438 Bickenhill Lane, continuing onto B4438 Bickenhill Parkway before reaching the A452 longabout. At the longabout traffic will take the third exit onto the A452 southbound towards the roundabout taking the second exit joining the A452 Chester Road southbound towards Stonebridge Island where the diversion route will end.



East Way slip road diversion route


East Way diversion route

East Way eastbound traffic

Road users wishing to join onto the A45 Coventry Road eastbound from East Way will need to follow the fully signed diversion route. After turning left onto East Way take the second exit at the roundabout and continue along East Way before taking the first exit at the roundabout onto Pendigo Way. Take the second exit at the next roundabout onto the A45 Coventry Road eastbound towards the junction of Stonebridge Island (near Toby Carvery - Stonebridge) where the diversion will end.

A45 Coventry Road westbound traffic

A45 Coventry Road westbound traffic exiting the A45 Coventry Road will still have access to Middle Bickenhill Lane via the Service Road loop. Traffic will only be able to make a left turn at the Tjunction. No right turns will be permitted onto the A45 Coventry Road East Way slip road. Road users heading south on Pendigo Way will still have access to Middle Bickenhill Lane but will not be able to access to A45 Coventry Road 'East Way' slip road. Traffic will need to follow the fully signed diversion route.
