Become a supplier to HS2

This guide helps prospective suppliers find out how to identify and access opportunities on HS2, Britain's new high-speed railway connecting London, the West Midlands and beyond.

HS2 creates a corridor of economic and social opportunity attracting new investment for businesses, jobs and homes, improving productivity.

Built to the highest standards, HS2 will take pressure off the existing transport network, laying the foundation to move more people, more quickly and reliably than ever before. The project will deliver 140 miles of new track, four new stations, new trains, two depots, 65 miles of tunnels,

44 miles of cuttings, 38 miles of embankments, 50 viaducts and 175 bridges. It will provide zero-carbon journeys for generations to come.

Businesses in every region and nation of the UK are helping to build HS2 – join us to deliver this great national endeavour.

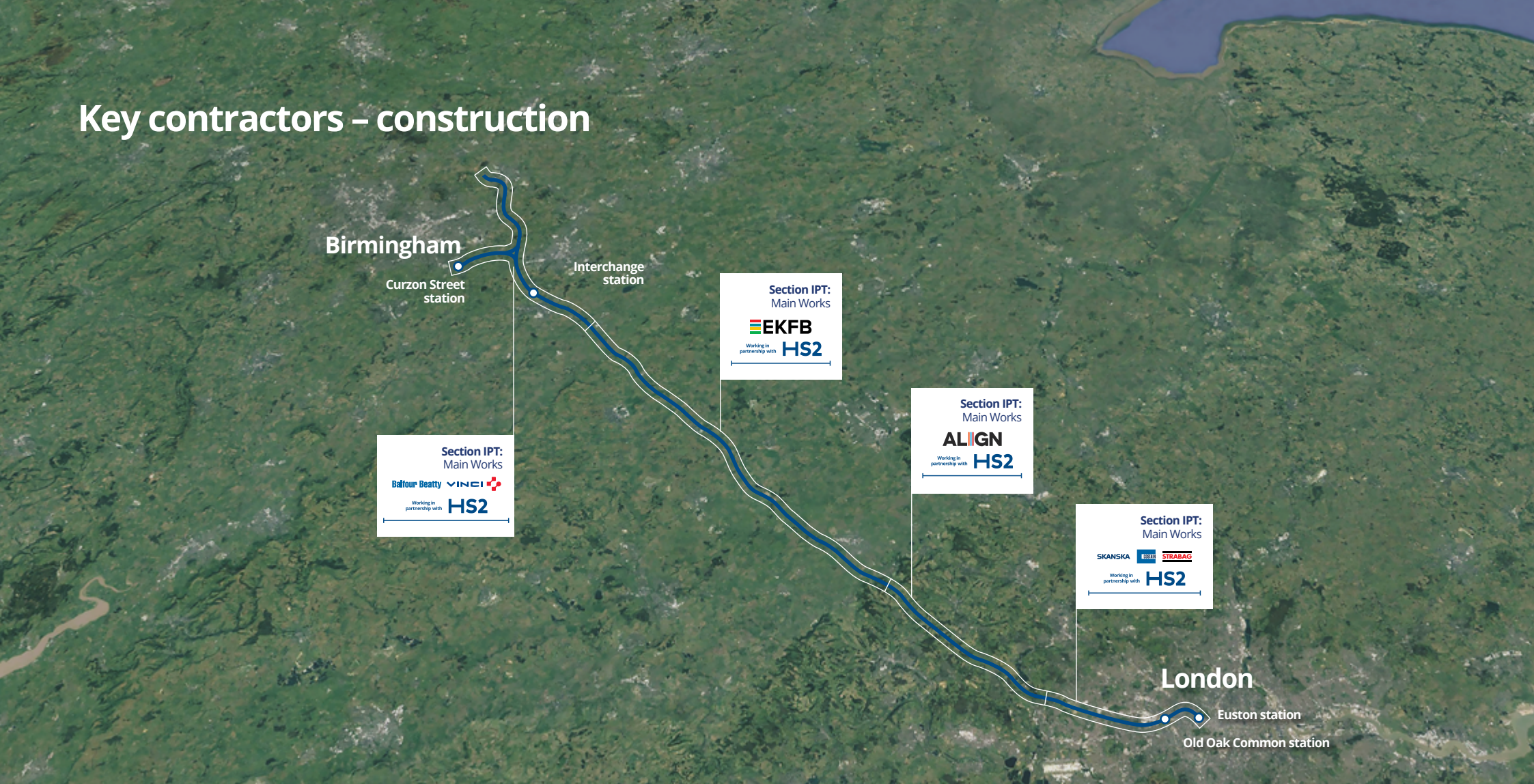

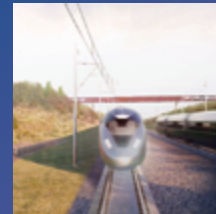
