# The work we will be doing

The new railway will pass over the M42 motorway on a box structure near the Birmingham Business Park and the NEC. The box structure, measuring 300 metres in length and 25 metres wide, will cover around 130 metres of the M42 motorway and is being constructed while the motorway is in operation.

As we progress with our construction activities, we will install temporary overnight lane closures on both northbound and southbound carriageways, to undertake some maintenance works that are not safe to be done around live traffic.

To complete our work, we will install lane closures as below:

# Overnight lanes 2 and 3 closure on the M42 motorway between junction 6 and 7a (northbound) and junction 7 and 6 (southbound)

- from 9pm Wednesday 2 April to 5am Thursday 3 April 2025
- from 9pm Thursday 3 April to 5am Friday 4 April 2025
- from 9pm Friday 4 April to 5am Saturday 5 April 2025


