Notice of Road Closure A418 Oxford Road and Meadoway

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. If you have any questions or enquiries about our work, please contact our Helpdesk to find out more. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2inyourarea.co.uk.

What are we doing?

In early April until the end of June, we will be carrying out a connection to bring into use the new gas pipe along the new road alignment. This requires an excavation close to the Meadoway junction. It is necessary to close this junction while we complete this work. These works involve a weekend closure of the A418 Oxford Road in early April, followed by the closure of Meadoway junction until June.

The planned weekend road closure of the A418 Oxford Road in early April is to install temporary barriers across the Meadoway junction and complete multiple works to include drainage, utility and verge works.

During the A418 Oxford Road weekend closure, pedestrian and cycle access will be maintained via a footpath diversion. Cyclists will be required to dismount through the closure.

The Meadoway junction road closure is required to safely complete gas utility diversion works. Access for Meadoway and Mayflower Close residents will be maintained via the Sedrup Lane junction.

When will these works take place?

A418 Oxford Road weekend road closure for vehicles (pedestrian and cycle access will be maintained)

Friday 4th April 8.30pm to Monday 7th April 5.30am

Meadoway junction road closure to vehicles (pedestrian and cycle access will be maintained)

• Friday 4th April 8.30pm to Monday 30th June 5.30am

These dates may change due to conditions outside of our control. Please refer to the HS2 website regularly to check for any changes and updates.

Provide updates for communities and maintain regular contact points for the duration of the work.





Where will these works take place? (con't)

The map below shows the access route from Meadoway to the A418 Oxford Road during the weekend road closure:

- There will be a diversion route for Meadoway and Mayflower Close access via Sedrup Lane.
- Pedestrian and cycle access along the old Oxford Road will be maintained through the closure. Cyclists will be required to dismount.
- No emergency access will be possible through the closure.
- Unfortunately, there will be disruption to the existing bus services between Aylesbury and Thame. A free replacement shuttle service will be in place between Stone and Thame. Revised bus service timetables will be available as soon as possible via the following link:



Where will these works take place? (con't)

The map below shows the location of the Meadoway junction road closure and diversion route to access the A418 Oxford Road:

- Pedestrian and cycle access to Meadoway from the A418 Oxford Road will be maintained.
- There will be a diversion route for Meadoway traffic via Sedrup Lane.
- No emergency access will be possible through the closures due to the nature of the works
