Advance notice of utility works in South Hampstead

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

What we are doing

We will be diverting the gas main in South Hampstead to protect it before tunnelling for HS2 starts in the area. These works will take place in six phases between **21 July 2025 and 17 July 2026** on Finchley Road, College Crescent, Hilgrove Road and Alexandra Road.

The location and traffic management for each phase is shown on pages two and three. We will send out further details before the works start, and as works progress.

How this might affect you

There will be lane and road closures, traffic diversions, bus stop suspensions and parking bay suspensions.

Clear signage will be in place to inform motorists, cyclists and pedestrians about the works and traffic diversions.

There will be some noise from excavation works. We will use noise reducing barriers where possible.

Your utility services will not be affected.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience these works may cause.



Below is an outline of the traffic management for each phase. All dates are subject to change. We will send out further details before the works start, and as works progress.

The dates of utility works such as these can be likely to change, as we sometimes find things which we weren't expecting. This means additional works may be needed.
