



Updated Notice of A45 Coventry road lane and carriageway overnight closures and East Way slip road one week closure – near Bickenhill

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

The new high-speed railway will pass under the A45 Coventry Road as it approaches the new Interchange station being built in Solihull. To enable HS2 to pass under the A45, a new overbridge will be constructed which will carry the eastbound and westbound carriageways and its two adjoining slip roads known as East Way and Service Road.

The A45 Coventry Road Overbridge will be constructed in phases. The first phase of construction is to complete the two slip road bridges and connect these to the existing slip roads, before traffic can be switched onto the new bridges and road realignments. To undertake these works safely we will require additional overnight traffic management (highlighted in blue below)

A45 Coventry Road eastbound and westbound overnight lane closures between M42 motorway j6 and Stonebridge Island

- Thursday 8 May and **Friday 9 May 2025** between 9pm and 6am

A45 Coventry Road westbound slip road and overnight lane closures - Stonebridge Island to M42 motorway j6

- Each night from Monday 12 May to Saturday 17 May 2025 between 9pm to 6am.

A45 eastbound carriageway overnight closures

Overnight eastbound carriageway closures between M42 motorway j6 and Stonebridge Island.

- Monday 19 May and **Tuesday 20 May 2025** between 9pm and 6am.

Following these closures lane 1 will remain closed until Autumn 2025

East Way slip road closure

- From 9pm Wednesday 21 May to 6am Thursday 29 May 2025

Overnight lane closures on the A45 Coventry Road eastbound and westbound carriageways: Thursday 8 May and Friday 9 May 2025 between 9pm and 6am.

A45 Coventry Road overnight westbound slip road and lane closures: Each night from Monday 12 May to Saturday 17 May 2025 between 9pm to 6am.

A45 eastbound overnight carriageway closures: Monday 19 May and Tuesday 20 May 2025 between 9pm and 6am.

Full one week closure of the East Way slip road from: From 9pm Wednesday 21 May to 6am on Thursday 29 May 2025

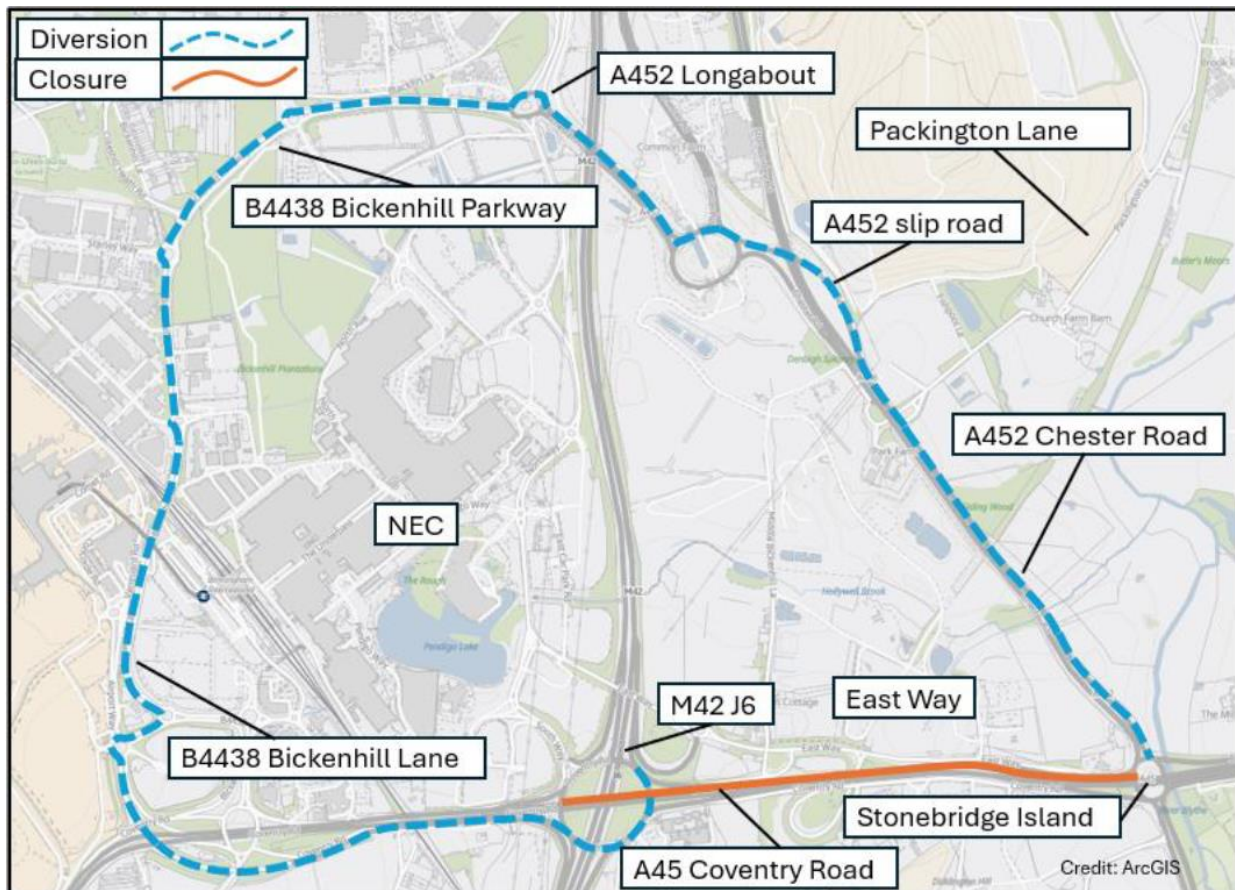
A45 Coventry Road eastbound carriageway diversion

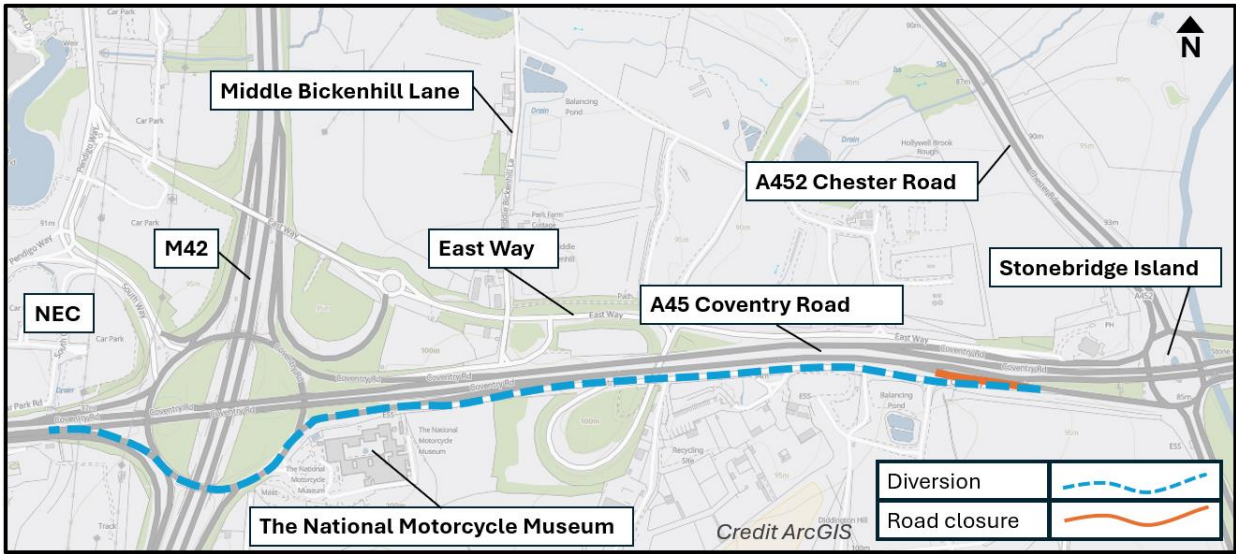
A45 Coventry Road westbound slip road diversion

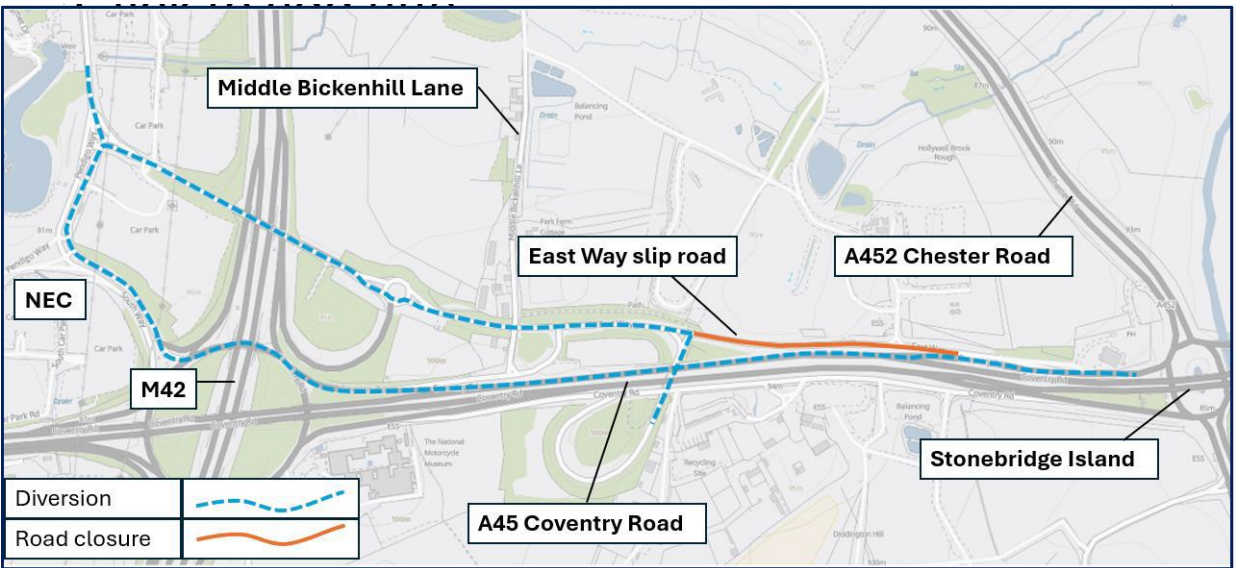
