What are we doing?

In this area we are building the Greatworth Green Tunnel, which extends through Banbury Road in Thorpe Mandeville.

To complete the tunnel excavation and construction, a section of Banbury Road will be close for approximately two years. The Greatworth Temporary Road will form part of the diversion route.

Once the tunnel is complete Banbury Road will be rebuilt over the top of the tunnel and the surrounding area will be landscaped.

When will these works take place?

From **Monday 12 May 2025** Banbury Road in Thorpe Mandeville will be closed for approximately two years.

These dates may be subject to local authority consents and approvals change, and circumstances outside of our control, such as poor weather.

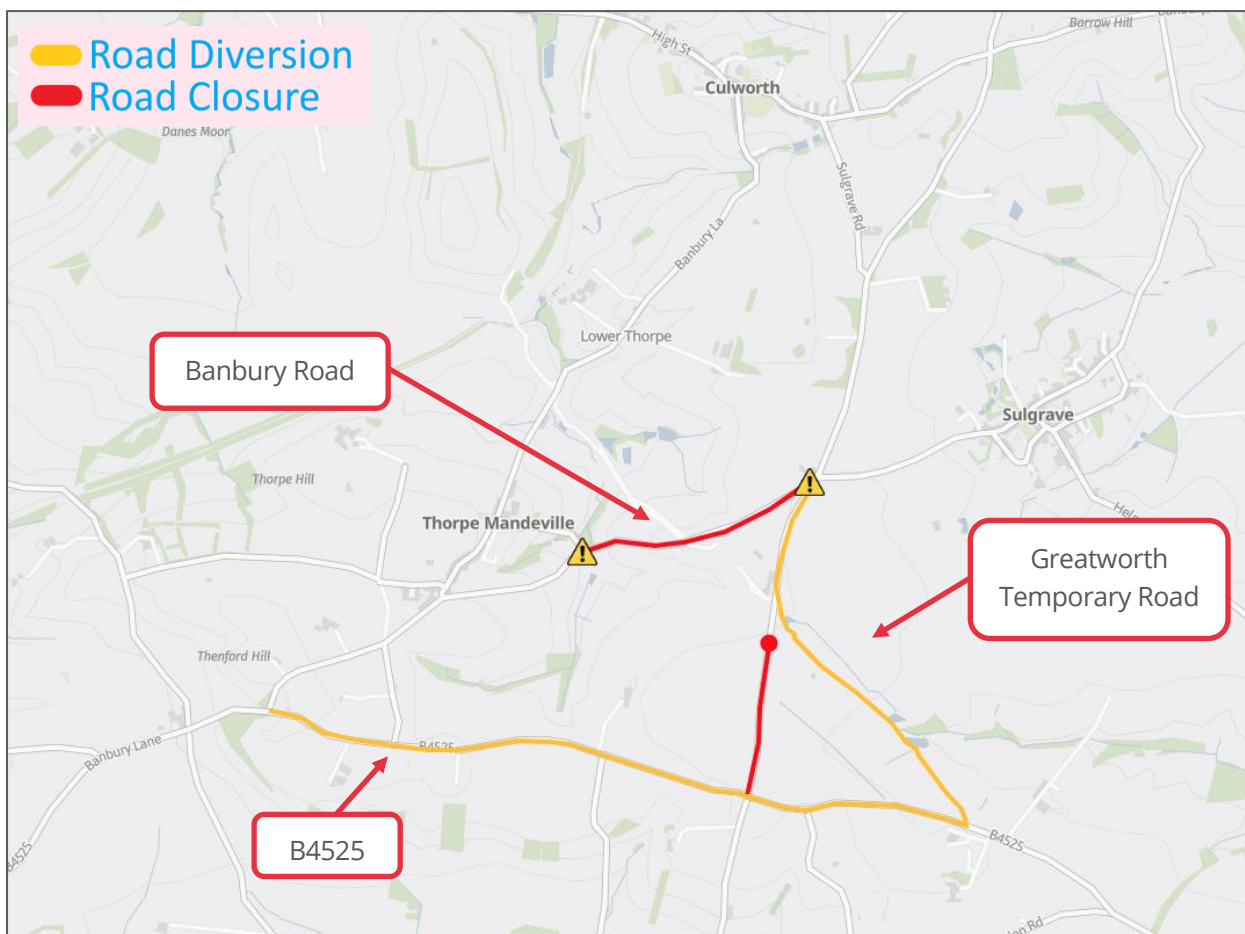

Where will the works take place?

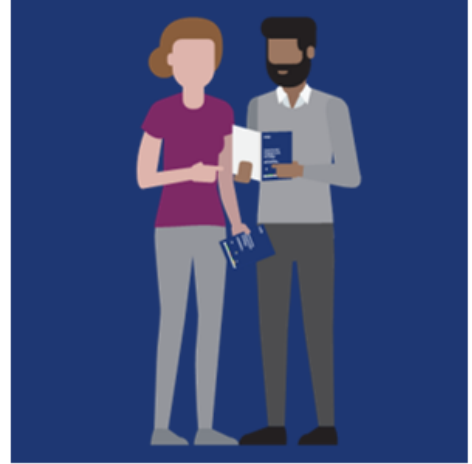
A section of Banbury Road, Thorpe Mandeville will be closed for approximately two years, with the Greatworth Temporary Road providing the diversion route.
