High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Hoarding works on Victoria Road, North Acton

Each Saturday from **3 May to 17 May 2025**, we will replace and paint the Victoria Road Crossover Box site hoarding along Victoria Road.

These works will take place between 8am and 1pm on Saturdays.

What to expect

These works will involve a partial footpath closure and pedestrian diversion route.

Traffic management will be in place during working hours only.

You may hear noise from handheld tools used to replace and paint the hoarding. We will aim to minimise disruption where possible.
