

Notice of road closure on Crackley Lane, Kenilworth

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

We will be carrying out utility and drainage installation works on Crackley Lane. To complete these works safely we will need to close a section of Crackley Lane between Blind Lane, Cryfield Grange Road and South Hurst Farm.

When will these works be taking place?

These works will take place from **Monday 2 June to Saturday 21 June 2025** and will be in place 24 hours a day.

A fully signposted diversion will be in place during the closure. Access to all properties will be maintained throughout. There will be **no access for pedestrians and cyclists**.

Please note the A429 will be closed from Monday 2 June 2025 to Saturday 28 June 2025 (see map overleaf).

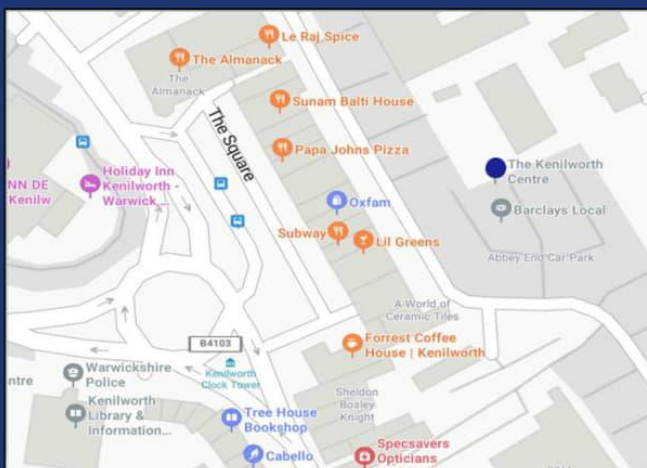
