## Notice of utility diversion works – National Exhibition Centre, Birmingham

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. To allow for the construction of the new railway and to continue to ensure a safe and reliable gas supply, Cadent needs to divert a gas pipeline in Marston Green, Birmingham.

#### What we are doing

Cadent will be starting work to move the pipeline within the National Exhibition Centre (NEC) complex in **June 2025**.

The work will involve:

- Securing our working area and compound off Pendigo Way with fencing
- Digging a trench for the new pipeline off Pendigo Way
- Welding the pipe together then installing it in the trench
- Connecting and testing the new pipe

Work will take place within the NEC complex only. Please note, there will be no on-site lodging.

Cadent expects that the work will be completed by early October 2025.

#### How this will affect you

Works will require construction vehicles accessing the working area from Pendigo Way, with signs in place to make people aware.

So vehicles can access the site safely, there will be a single-lane closure on the northbound section of Pendigo Way, adjacent to Pendigo Lake. The right hand lane will remain open for people using the NEC, and Cadent will man the entrance to its site to enable a smooth flow of traffic.

Cadent continues to work closely with the NEC team to ensure traffic management measures do not disrupt activity taking place at the NEC.

Work will mainly take place within standard HS2 hours, though during June and July the NEC team have agreed that we can work from 8am to 6pm on weekends as well, to complete excavation activity as efficiently as possible.

Standard construction vehicles and equipment will be used, and we do not anticipate any additional noise or disruption for visitors to the NEC. We will keep people up to date as the work progresses.

- Our working hours will mainly be 8.00am to 6.00pm (Monday-Friday) and 8.00am to 1.00pm (weekends), with some work taking place until 6.00pm on weekends in June and July.

- Pipeline diversion works taking place within the National Exhibition Centre (NEC) complex.
- No disruption to utilities.

#### What we will do

- Make sure all construction vehicles use agreed routes.
- Maintain a safe working environment.
- Inform people in advance of any changes.
