



# Notice of A4010 Risborough Road closures

## What are we doing?

**De vegetation works** - In May we will be completing de vegetation works along the A4010 Risborough Road, near the new Stoke Mandeville relief road at the point it connects with the existing carriageway.

This will involve the removal of a small number of trees opposite Freemantle Court as part the continuing road realignment works in this area. The existing trees are located at the point the new relief road will tie into the existing carriageway. They need to be removed in order to allow construction of drainage for the new highway.

**Temporary bridge inspection** – In June, there will be an overnight road closure of the A4010 Risborough Road to conduct a routine inspection of the temporary bridge used by EKFB vehicles.

## When will these works take place?

- **There will be a daytime road closure Monday 19 May to Wednesday 21 May, 9am to 3pm (off peak).**
- **There will be an overnight road closure Monday 9 June 8.30pm to Tuesday 10 June 5.30am.**

These dates may change due to conditions outside of our control. Please refer to the HS2 website regularly to check for any changes and updates. We will endeavour to complete this works in and around the stated time frame.

## Duration of works

Three day road closure, Monday 19 May to Wednesday 21 May, off peak, 9am to 3pm.

Overnight road closure, Monday 9 June 8.30pm to Tuesday 10 June 5.30am.

Full road closures off peak and overnight with signed diversion route in place.

Increased travel times.

## What we will do

Minimise disruption as much as possible for the community.

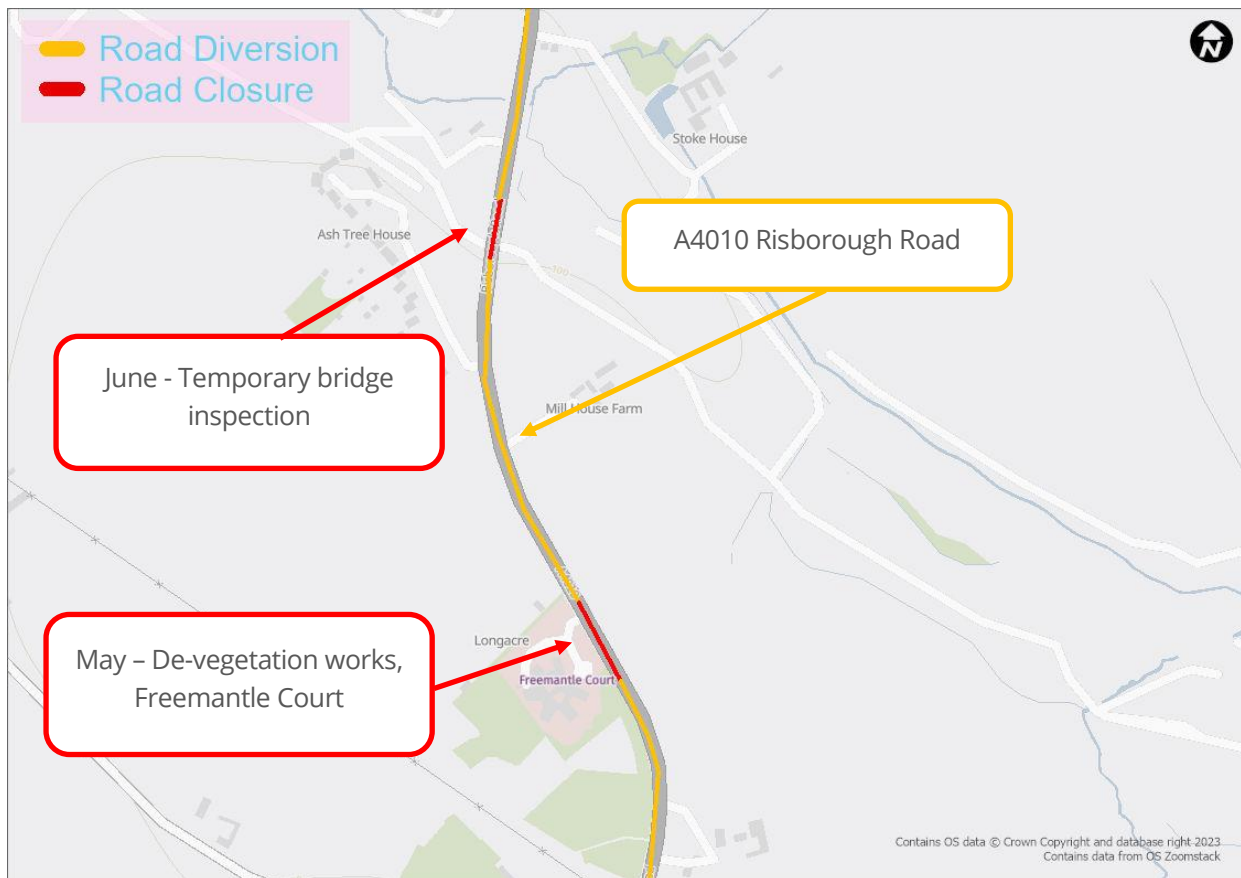

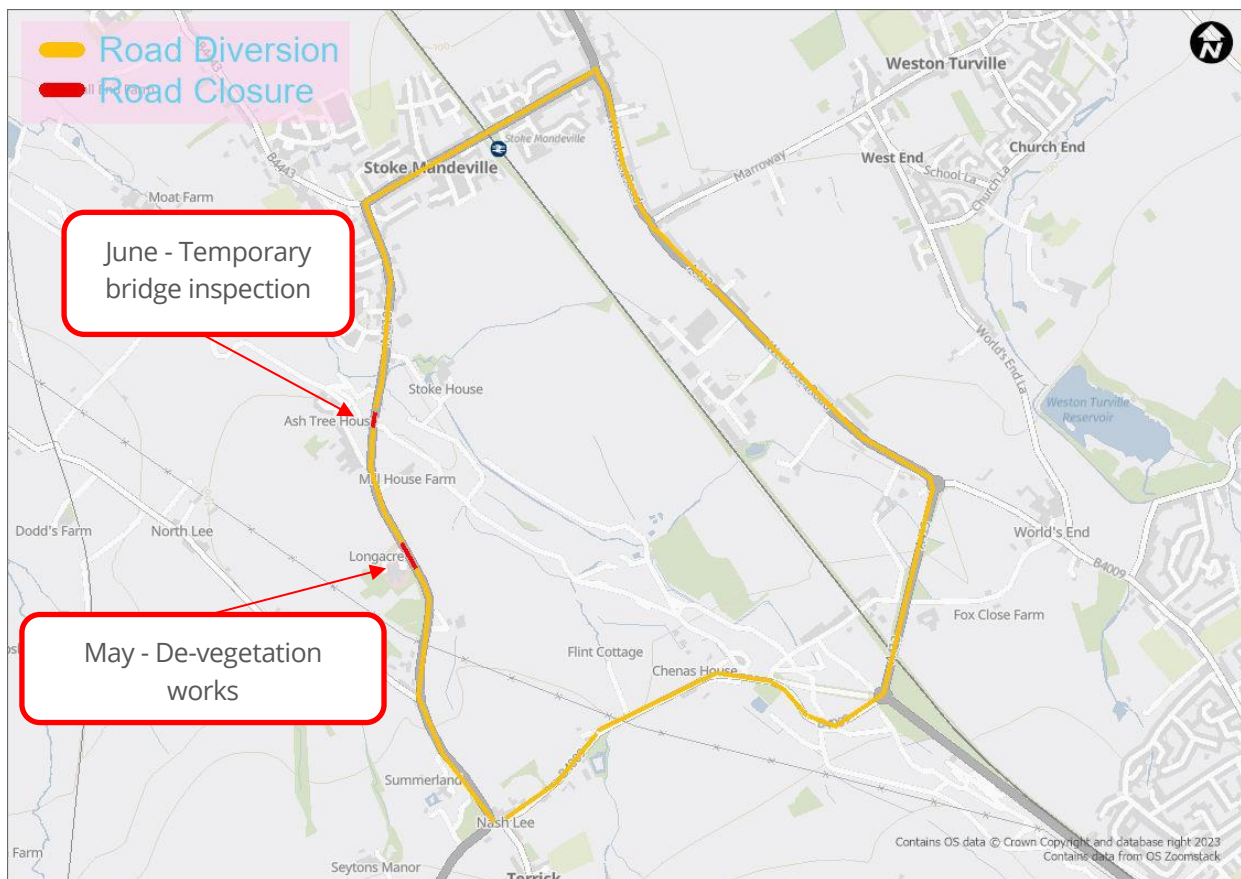
