Update - Extending the temporary closure of Welsh Road, near Southam

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area

The work we are doing

Construction of Welsh Road Underbridge was completed in November 2024. It is one of the first of 16 bridge structures to be built in South Warwickshire. Once the bridge was completed, works commenced on the new road realignment, which was progressed and opened for road users in February 2025.

While completing drainage work along a section of Welsh Road, during the current closure, our surveys have identified damaged pipes which will need to be replaced. To complete this work safely, we will extend the closure period of Welsh Road to Friday 27 June 2025.

When the work will be taking place

The road closure will be in place each day from:

Monday 16 June to Friday 27 June 2025, from 8am till 6pm.

What to expect

You may notice increased construction activity with some travel disruptions to your journey. Please follow the fully signed diversion on page two.
