Since March 2022 Bowood Lane has been closed to enable the construction of Bowood Lane over bridge.

As we progress with our works on the overbridge and in the area, access for motorised vehicles on Bowood Lane will remain restricted. This closure is necessary to ensure the safe completion of our works.

In April 2025, we opened the Bowood Lane overbridge for Public Right of Way use. The footpath across the bridge is now in use whilst the bridge is being constructed.

We expect the works to be sufficiently advanced to enable Bowood Lane to be open to traffic by August 2027.
