High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

CCTV maintenance on the A38 Carriageways

As we build the new high speed railway line in Lichfield to install the Rykneld Street Overbridge, we currently have traffic management in place on the A38 to safely complete these works.

To continue the safe running of the traffic management, we need to undertake maintenance works of the CCTV cameras on the A38 carriageways. The A38 northbound and southbound carriageways will be closed overnight for these works and a diversion route will be provided for vehicles travelling north and south during these closures.

When will the work take place

Northbound - Tuesday 8 July, Tuesday 12 August and Tuesday 16 September 2025 from 9pm to 5am.

Southbound - Wednesday 9 July, Wednesday 13 August and Wednesday 17 September 2025 from 9pm to 5am

Access to businesses and properties will be maintained.

These works are subject to consent.

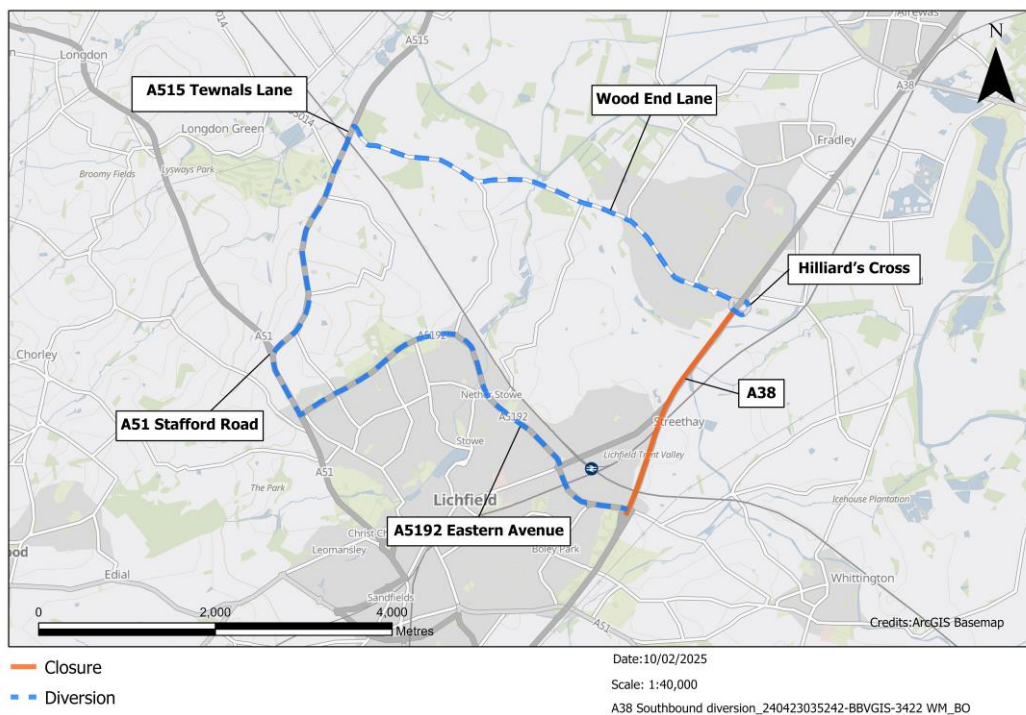

Diversion route

Northbound will be diverted off the A38 Northbound towards Cappers Lane, along the A5192 Eastern Avenue to A51 Stafford Road to the A515 Tewnals Lane, along Wood End Lane to rejoin the A38 Northbound carriageway.

Southbound will be diverted along Wood End Lane to A515 Tewnals Lane, along A51 Stafford Road to A5192 Eastern Avenue to rejoin the A38 Southbound carriageway.
