

# Road lining works in Flat Iron worksite

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

### **Removal of road markings**

Between **4pm and 6pm** on **Tuesday 24 June 2025** we plan to remove the road markings within our Flat Iron site.

We will consider the following contingency hours to complete this work: 4pm to 6pm on one afternoon between Wednesday 25 June and Friday 27 June or from 10am to 12pm on Saturday 28 June.

We will use a thermal torch which is equipped with a safety alarm to remove the markings. You may hear this alarm during works.

These works are needed to improve visibility for vehicles and pedestrian safety. We apologise in advance for any disruption caused.

### **Overnight works**

Between **8pm and 5am** from **Tuesday 24 June** to **Friday 27 June 2025**, we will be refreshing some road linings within our Flat Iron site.

During these works you may hear some noise from the works and vehicles.
