The dates and information included in this look ahead are subject to change as our programme develops. For the latest information on our works, please visit the <u>HS2 in Camden</u> website or our In Your Area map.

The document includes:

- A list of construction activities planned in the next three months; and
- Works to be aware of that will take place in the next 12 months but may not yet have been confirmed.

The document is divided into three main areas.

- Adelaide Road
- Euston Approaches
- Euston Station

Locations are colour coded to help you easily understand if the works are carried out within one of our worksites or on the street:

- **Purple**: Works on site (inside our hoardings)
- **Blue**: Works on the street (outside our hoardings)

Area 1 - Adelaide Road



Location of works	Proposed duration	Description of works
Location 1 Adelaide Road site	Autumn 2025 to autumn 2026	Works at the Adelaide Road Ventilation Shaft and Headhouse site were brought to a safe stop in May 2024. Work will continue to remain on pause for the next two years.
		The hoarding will remain in place, and there will be 24-hour security. Some non-intrusive works, such as monitoring, and design work will continue.
		The local engagement team and the HS2 Helpdesk are still available to answer your questions.
Location 2 Camden Winding	Ongoing autumn 2024 to autumn 2026	Ongoing surveys are taking place to understand the structural nature and condition of the Camden Winding Vaults.
Vaults		The surveys will inform any future monitoring, and mitigation works needed in advance of tunnelling works through this area.

		The works include the removal of spoil, rubbish and flood water, and the installation of scaffolding, ventilation and monitoring equipment. Scaffolding will remain in place, with surveys to take place regularly. We will write to you in advance of any work that might impact you.
South Hampstead, Swiss Cottage, Finchley Road area	From July 2025 to July 2026	Gas diversion works in the Swiss Cottage area from July 2025 to July 2026 These works are planned to take place in phases with some lane closures and partial road closures required across Finchley Road, College Crescent, Hilgrove Road and Alexandra Road.
Various locations, Camden	Autumn 2025 to autumn 2026	We will carry out bridge and heritage surveys in various locations along HS2 London tunnels route. The surveys will inform future works to protect these third-party assets during the construction of the tunnels. We'll write to you if these works will impact you. We'll begin building the twin-bore Euston tunnel with two tunnel boring machines heading towards Adelaide Road. We will write to you in advance of any work that might impact you.

Area 2 - Euston Approaches




Location of works	Proposed duration	Description of works
Location 1 Vehicle holding area	Ongoing	The vehicle holding area will be in operation until major construction works are complete. This avoids lorries queueing in streets near worksites.
Location 2	Ongoing	Track-level weekend works
Camden Cutting		Track-level surveys and monitoring within the railway cutting.
		For safety, due to the proximity of the works to the tracks, these works can only be carried out overnight during the weekend when the tracks are not in use.
	Ongoing until Autumn 2025	In the Euston Cavern , works are ongoing to reinforce and protect the Network Rail retaining wall. These works will continue until Autumn 2025.
Location 2a Mornington Street Bridge	Ongoing	Mornington Street bridge is currently open with a 3-tonne weight limit in place which we are managing with width restriction barriers at both end of the bridge.
		For safety reasons, Network Rail and SCS will continue to monitor the bridge whilst work continues beneath it.
		Please note once we begin tunnelling, the bridge will be closed throughout the works which are expected to take five years to complete. We will update you in advance of closing the bridge.
Location 2b	Ongoing until	Euston Scissor Box
Camden Cutting south	autumn 2025	We are continuing works to strengthen and protect the Network Rail retaining wall that runs along Park Village East to ensure the wall can safely withstand the movement caused by our works. We expect this to be complete by autumn 2025.
		Additional maintenance and hoarding works will also continue until autumn 2025.

Location 3	May 2024	Granby Terrace Bridge works
Euston Throat worksite	onwards	The Granby Terrace Bridge deck extension was completed in November 2024 and finishing works are due to be complete by summer 2025. We are continuing works to redirect utilities off Hampstead Road and on to the bridge. For safety, some of this work must be done at night during weekends when the tracks below are not in use. The bridge will remain closed to the public until construction works in the Euston Approaches are complete. We cannot safely open the bridge to vehicles or pedestrians while carrying out major construction works in this area. We will endeavour to carry out noisy works during the day, and quieter works at night.
	Ongoing until winter 2025	Network Rail wall removal In March 2025, we began works to remove a section of the Network Rail retaining wall. Due to the proximity of the wall to the live railway, we will continue to adjust scaffolding to allow us to complete work safely during core working hours. We expect to complete the work by winter 2025.
Location 3a	Autumn 2025	Siite preparation and piling
Zone 5 worksite		From autumn 2025, we will start to set up the site ahead of piling work, which will include the installation of cabins and electrical connections. There will be a site office and welfare building with connection to mains power. More information about our piling methods can be found in our piling factsheet.

Location 3b, 3c Hampstead	Ongoing until early 2026	Hampstead Road utility works Temporary utility diversion
Road and Varndell Street		We need to divert the utilities on Hampstead Road before we can begin work to extend the bridge. Now we have extended Granby Terrace bridge, we are diverting the utilities on Hampstead Road across Granby Terrace. We will complete these works by early 2026.

		Each phase will require road, lane or footpath closures and parking bay suspensions. An update on above works can be found here .
Location 4a, 4b, 4c and 4d	Ongoing until winter 2026	Cable pulling – lane, road and footpath closures
Stanhope Street, Lidlington Place, Varndell		We previously installed a new cable route from Lidlington Place to Varndell Street via Granby Terrace, to replace the existing route next to Hampstead Road.
Street and Hampstead Road		Now that we have installed the ducting which will form the cable route, the next stage is to pull the cables through the pipes. We do this by pulling cables between underground cable joint bays located on the route.
		From May to December 2025, we will complete these works in seven phases. Information on above works can be found here .

Area 3 - Euston Station



Location of works	Proposed duration	Description of works
Location 1 Main site	Ongoing	In spring, we began clearing the site of materials in preparation for the continuation of the exhumations of St James Garden burial area. The exhumation area will be on the border of Network Rail's boundary wall.
Location 2 Hampstead Road	Ongoing	Works to construct a new sewer chamber in the existing manhole is progressing. These works will enable decommissioning of the existing sewer at the North of Cardington Street and Melton Street. Upcoming works include:

- Alteration of the existing hoarding line to facilitate works;
- Deep excavation of the sewer cofferdam;
- Secondary diversions; and
- Ground clearance.

UK Power Networks ducting works

Later this year UKPN will complete ducting works along Hampstead Road. These works will help to enable the new electricity substations being installed within our site. Varndell Street will remain closed to facilitate the work on Hampstead Road.

Works will include:

- Realignment of hoarding on Hampstead Road;
- Breakout of the road surface; and
- Traffic management on the carriage way.

Staff access gate

From June, we will begin construction of our secondary staff access gate. This gate will provide access into our site office.

Works will include:

- Temporary alteration to a pedestrian walkway;
- Installations of turnstiles; and
- Alterations to the hoarding.

Pedestrian access will be maintained while the works are taking place.

Location 3 Starcross Street

Ongoing

Work is progressing to construct a temporary and permanent UKPN substation (adjacent to the skills centre and behind the hoarding). The permanent substation will enable electricity into the main site.

Construction works to the upper floors of the Maria Fidelis Old school is continuing. These works will facilitate our future staff accommodation.

Ongoing works include:

- Repair of a sewer connection;
- Under pining of a party wall;
- Piling works for a permanent substation;
- Installation of new cables into the substation;
- Suspension of parking bays;
- Reinstatement of the road surface;

		 Installation of scaffold; Internal fitout and refurbishment works; and Construction of a link bridge.
Location 4 Cobourg Street	Ongoing	Essential utility works behind the hoarding on Cobourg Street is continuing. Our next phase of work includes: • Connection into a manhole adjacent to
		 Euston Street; Excavation for UKPN Power ductwork; Backfill & resurfacing for UKPN Power ductwork; Removal of thestaff entrance on Cobourg Street; Temporary footpath closure of Cobourg Street South to facilitate UKPN and gas main diversion works; and Ongoing realignment of hoardings and walkways to facilitate works.
		Cobourg Street remains closed to vehicles.
Location 5 Drummond Street	Until late December 2025	In April 2025, Virgin Media completed the first phase of work to relocate a communication cable to facilitate the gas main diversion works on Drummond Street.
		The remaining phases will begin in early June and continue until late December 2025. During the works, pedestrian access to properties will be maintained.
		Works include:
		 Temporary lane closure of Drummond Street (no vehicle access to Charles Place and Exmouth Mews); Full road closure of Drummond Street for approximately 12 weeks; Parking and loading bays suspensions; and Ongoing realignment of hoardings and walkways to facilitate the work.

Location 6 Euston Street (6a)	Until September 2025	In April, we began gas main diversions on Euston Street. Work is ongoing and we expect the works to be completed in September 2025.

Street (6b		 Concrete breakout and excavations; Diversion of the existing gas main; Temporary work sites; Parking bays suspensions.
		The use of temporary traffic lights.We will return in early 2026 to begin sewer and watermain diversion works on Euston Street.
Location 7 Stephenson Way	Until early 2026	To enable the construction of the UKPN substation within our site we will undertake power ducting installations adjacent to Stephenson Way.
		Works include:
		 Temporary vehicle access closure a section of Stephenson Way; Temporary closure of a turning circle; Hoarding realignment; Breakout of road surface; e and Temporary worksite.
		Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
Location 8 Traction sub station	Ongoing	Work is progressing at the site and in May 2025 we decommissioned the acoustic shed. The acoustic shed was built to allow us to contain construction noise from the new Traction Substation. During summer 2025 inspections to the new structure will continue. This will enable power migration which will begin from Autumn 2025.
		Upcoming and ongoing works include:
		 Inspections to the new structure; Installation of lighting and small power cables; Removal of materials; Power migration; and Activation of the vent fan.
Location 9	Ongoing	Gas main works
Melton Street		We are continuing with gas main works within the site. We expect these works to continue until early 2026.

		London Underground Chambers
		In 2024 we completed London Underground chambers 1 (Cobourg Street) and 2 (adjacent to Stephenson Way). From June 2025 we will begin works to chambers 3 (adjacent to Stephenson Way), 4 and 5 (Melton Street).
		Ongoing works include;
		 Relocation of Melton Street walkway and hoarding (adjacent to West Gardens); and Hoarding realignment on Stephenson Way.
Location 10 Eversholt Street	August 2025 f	In April, we completed CCTV surveys on Eversholt Street from August for approximately 8 weeks. Weneed to return and complete phase 2 of the surveys to inform the future design of the gas main on Eversholt Street.
		Works include:
		Suspension of loading bays;Temporary work sites; andExcavation works.
		We will return later to begin the gas main diversion, and we will keep you informed ahead of the start of work.
