What we are doing

From **2 August to 1 November 2025**, we will be working 24 hours a day, seven days a week to remove sections of the conveyor within the Flat Iron site and next to Dudding Hill Line bridge on Victoria Road.

The conveyor, which has been used for transporting excavated material from the Northolt Tunnel excavation work, is no longer needed as the work is now completed.

The dates for the different phases of works are on the next page.

How we will remove the conveyor

We will disconnect the conveyor from its supports using a crane. Once this is done the conveyor will be lifted to ground level and taken apart within the site.

How this may affect you

You may notice noise from construction machinery and tools. Noisier works will be carried out during the day. We will use noise reducing barriers where possible.

We will use floodlighting and direct the lighting away from local properties.

In October 2025 we will remove the section of the conveyor next to Dudding Hill Line bridge. We will need to carry out some of this work over a weekend where we will need to have a road and footpath closure in place. Further details will be provided in September 2025.
