



# Temporary daytime closures of Diddington Lane – near Hampton-in-Arden

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

## The work we will be doing

We're building the railway to the northeast of Hampton-in-Arden. The route will cross Meriden Road and the River Blythe on a viaduct. It will then run in a cutting under Diddington Lane and the A45 Coventry Road near Bickenhill.

To enable us to continue with our construction activities we will need to undertake some vegetation clearance and complete trial holes.

We will require daytime closures of Diddington Lane to ensure a safe working environment for our workforce and road users.

## Diddington Lane closures

Each weekday from **Monday 4 August** to **Friday 8 August 2025** between **9.30am** and **3.30pm**

## Access to Diddington Lane properties and businesses

Access to properties to the south end of Diddington Lane will be via B4102 Meriden Road.

Station Farm access via B4102 Meriden Road with the assistance of traffic marshals.

Hampton Hill Farm, Diddington Farm and Diddington Manor access via A452 Kenilworth Road onto Diddington Lane, will be maintained during the off-peak closures, with the assistance of traffic marshals.

Please follow the fully signed diversion route and allow more time for journeys.

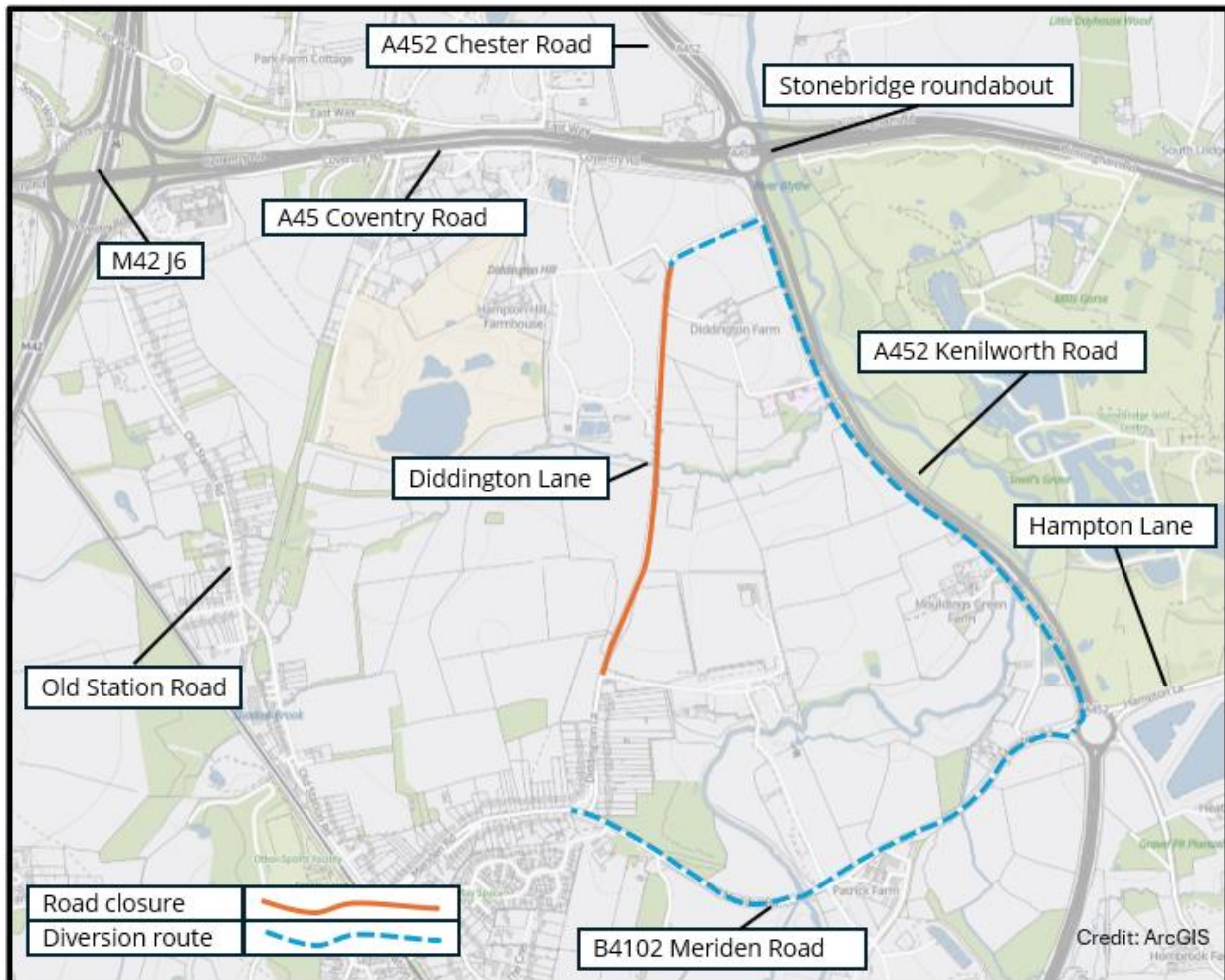
# Diddington Lane northbound diversion route

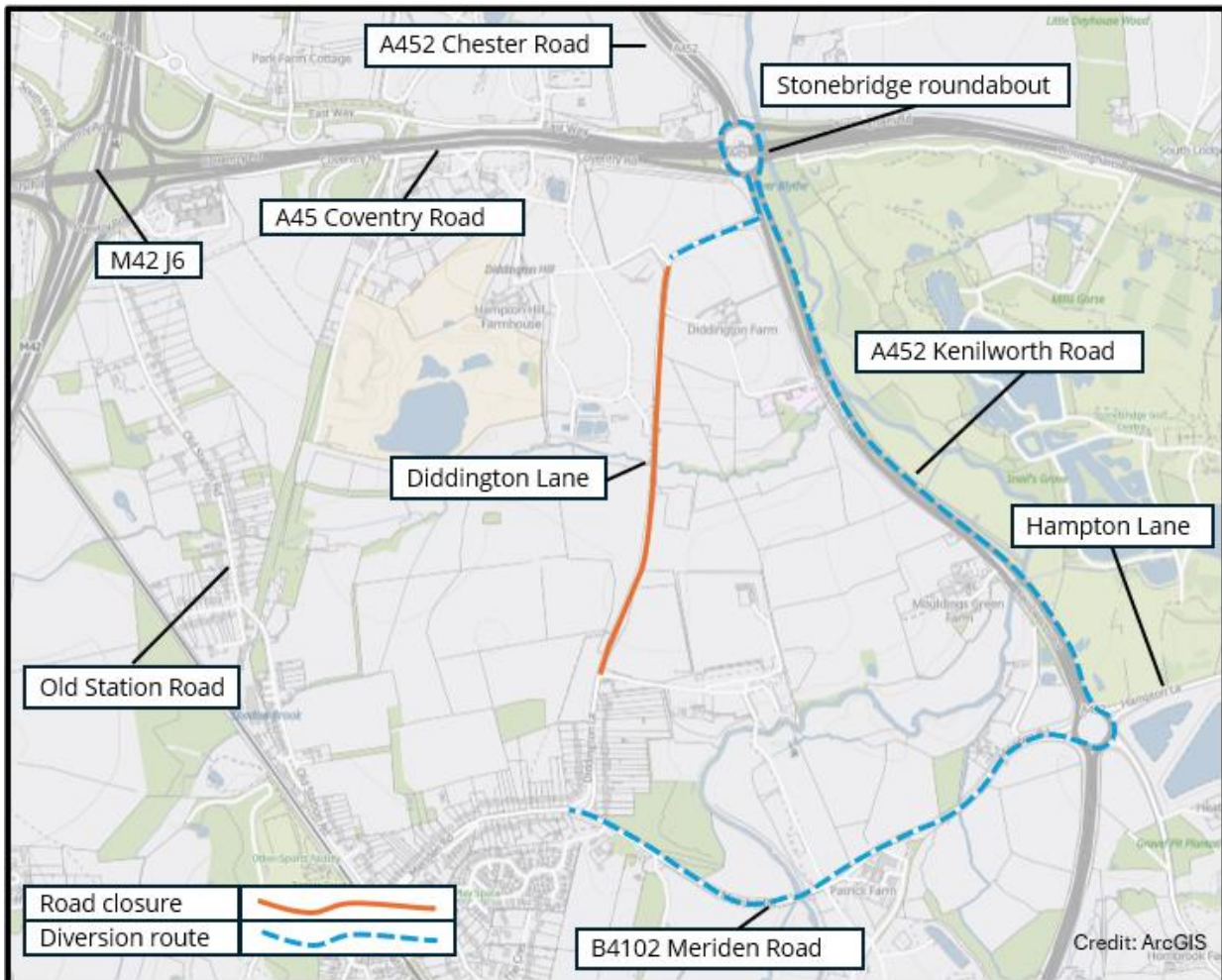
# Diddington Lane southbound diversion route
