High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

We are in the final phase of delivering the realigned A429 Kenilworth Road and the new overbridge. We need to finish the embankments, reinstate and resurface the footpaths, position final utilities and complete the final highway drainage works.

When will these works be taking place?

To carry out the works in a safe and secure environment, we will need to install temporary traffic lights for one week. We will also need to close the road whilst we complete the works.

The **temporary traffic lights** will be in place from **Monday 18 August** to **Tuesday 26 August 2025.** We will then close the road from **Tuesday 26 August** to **Saturday 20 September 2025.** The traffic lights and road closure will both be 24 hours a day.

Access to properties will be maintained throughout, with access for pedestrians and cyclists.

Our workforce may be on site one hour before and after, to set up and secure our equipment




