

# Notice of traffic management, A413 Wendover Bypass, Wendover

## What are we doing?

In September and October 2025, we will be constructing a new entrance from the Wendover Bypass for site vehicles to access the Wendover green tunnel compound. The work will include drainage tie-ins, subbase preparation, kerb installation, white line reconfiguration, new tarmac laying, and final white line painting.

To carry out these activities safely, traffic management (off-peak lane closures) will be required. To minimise impact, this traffic management will be in operation at off-peak times.

This notice will be updated in September for further works planned in October 2025.

## When will these works take place?

Overnight lane closures (8:30pm – 5:30am):

- **Friday 12 September – Monday 15 September 2025**
- **Friday 19 September – Monday 22 September 2025**
- **Friday 26 September – Monday 29 September 2025**
- **Friday 3 October – Monday 6 October 2025**

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control but works will be completed in or around the set timeframes.

Should our works be completed earlier than anticipated, we will commit to removing the traffic management upon completion.

Take care to respect the community.

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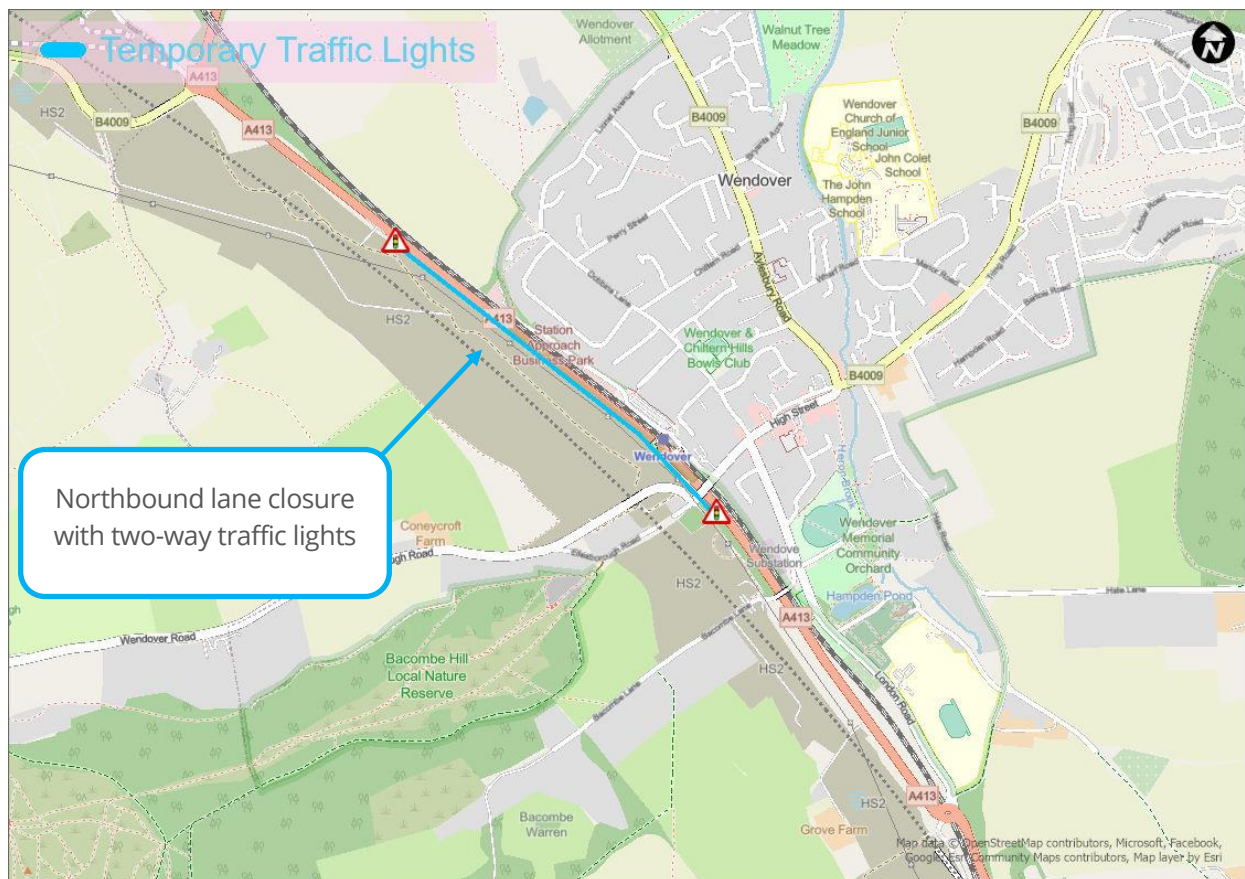
