High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

As part of our environmental mitigation work, we will be carrying out ecological surveys in the Cubbington area.

Our ecology team will be undertaking a series of surveys and inspections to identify and record local wildlife. To carry out the works safely we will need to close Coventry Road.

When these works will take place

You may notice additional activity on the highway. Our workforce may be on site up to one hour before and one hour after to set up and secure our equipment.


The diversion route
