High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

During this phase of the Fosse Way Overbridge construction, we will be working on carriageway drainage. To carry out these works safely, we will need to instal temporary traffic lights on Welsh Road.

When will these works be taking place?

Welsh Road temporary traffic lights will be in place from **Monday 1 September until Friday 12 September 2025 between 8.00am and 6.00pm**. There will be no traffic management in operation during the weekend.

What to expect

You may notice increased construction activity along the public highway with some minor travel disruptions to your journey. Please allow enough time for journeys. Access to properties, and for pedestrians and cyclists will be maintained.




