### What are we doing?

From early September 2025 there will be traffic management, in the form of 2-way temporary traffic lights, at the northern end of North Farm Lane, Quainton. This is to allow the installation by EKFB of the Thames Water main pillar protection housing on the grass verge.

A small area of vegetation clearance and a trial hole will be excavated to confirm the location before the pillar is erected in the identified spot.

This is for reasons of safety, as our operatives will be working on and around the carriageway.

### When will these works take place?

From 8 September 2025 to 12 September 2025 a section of North Farm Lane, Quainton will be under traffic management in the form of 2-way temporary traffic lights.

These dates may change due to conditions outside of our control, such as weather. Please refer to the HS2 website regularly to check for any changes and updates.

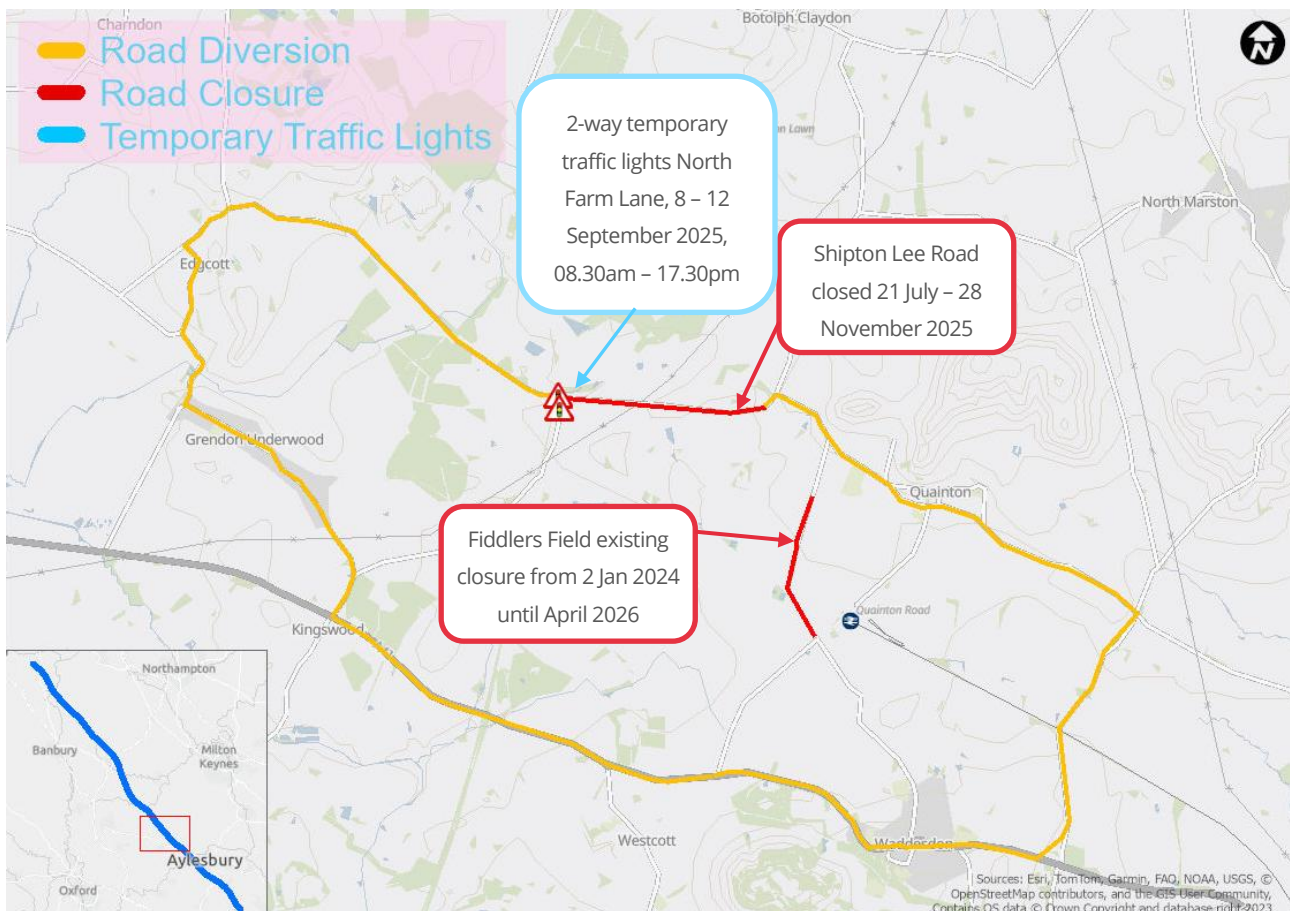
