## What are we doing?

EKFB are building a new road bridge and highway to allow the A423 to pass over the HS2 railway line, south of Southam.

As part of this design scheme we will be replacing the northbound layby between Ladbroke and Southam on the A423.

As we continue the construction of the new highway we will be closing the current layby until the completion of the road bridge and replacement layby, which is expected in summer 2026.

## When will these works take place?

The northbound layby on A423 between Ladbroke and Southam will be closed from Monday 18 August 2025 until summer 2026.

These dates may be subject to change, due to circumstances outside of our control, such as poor weather. This work is subject to local authority consents and approvals.

Closure of layby on A423 from Monday 18 August 2025 until summer 2026.

Take care to respect the community.

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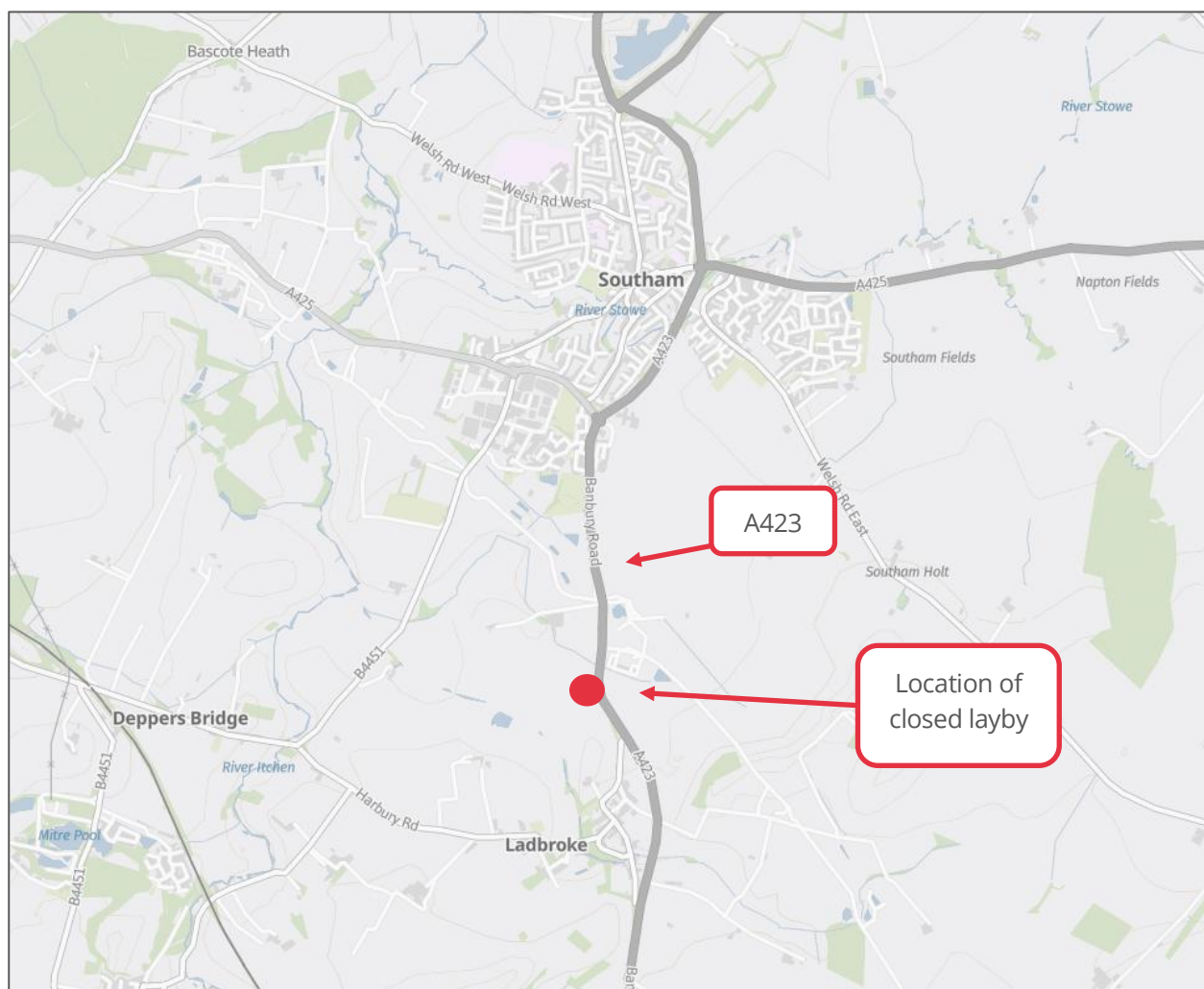
