



Notice of overnight lane closure on Lawley Middleway - Birmingham

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

As part of the new railway construction into Birmingham City Centre, our teams will be carrying out essential works at Lawley Middleway (between Garrison Circus and Curzon Circus).

This follows the successful installation of a 112m-long steel bridge section earlier this summer. We now need to remove some of the temporary sub-structure used during the bridge launch.

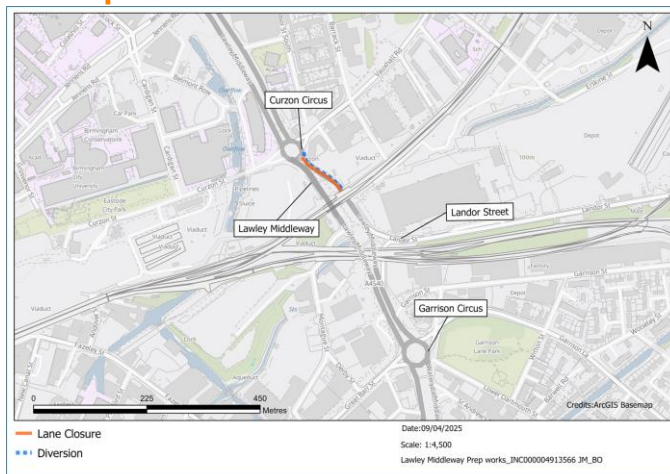
Upcoming closures:

Future works:

Further overnight closures are planned between Thursday 3 October – Friday 18 October to complete finishing works and fully remove the temporary sub-structure – we will write to you about this separately
