

## Notice of road closures, Wormleighton Road, Warwick Road and Stoneton Lane, Boddington

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. EKFB is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at [www.hs2innorthants.co.uk](http://www.hs2innorthants.co.uk).

### What are we doing?

The next stage of construction for the Banbury Road bridge, near Boddington, is to join and 'tie-in' the new sections of road into the existing highway, at both the east and west sides.

Details of the road closures required are set out below and maps showing the diversion routes are on the following pages:

#### Highways 'tie-in':

Sections of **Wormleighton Road** and **Warwick Road** will be closed for four weeks to complete the highway construction.

At this time, **Stoneton Lane** will close to build the Stoneton Lane Green overbridge, for approximately two years,

- To help to minimise the duration of the road closure, we will be working seven days a week, 24 hours a day.
- Access will be maintained to farmland around the construction site during the road closure.

#### Operation of a link road:

To restore local connectivity, once the tie-ins are completed, traffic will use the new sections of highway, and a temporary link road which crosses the construction area, south of the bridge.

We will open the bridge as soon as possible, once all outstanding works, consents and approvals have been completed.

### When will these works take place?

- **Wormleighton Road and Warwick Road will be closed:** Tuesday 26 August to Tuesday 23 September 2025
- **Stoneton Lane will be closed:** Tuesday 26 August 2025 for approximately 2 years.

### Duration of works

A section of Wormleighton Road and Warwick Road will be closed from 26 August to 23 September 2025.

Stoneton Lane will be closed from 26 August 2025 for approximately 2 years.

### Working hours:

24 hours a day.

### What to expect

Construction activities will include: road construction; excavation and landscaping; and installation of vehicle restraint system.

Some noise from plant and machinery and additional lighting.

The current, closed section of Banbury Road will open on 23 September.

### What we will do

Respond promptly to any enquiries and complaints and take appropriate action.

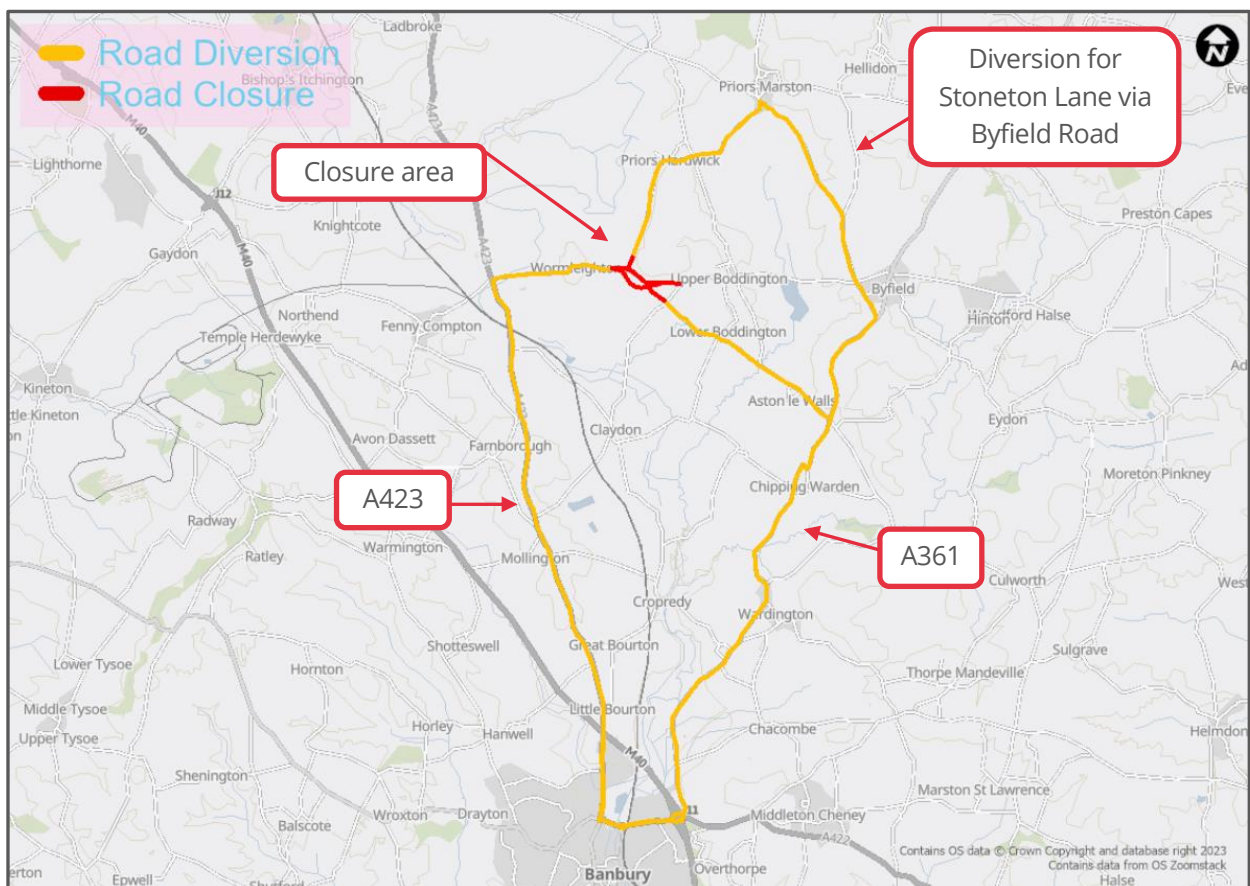

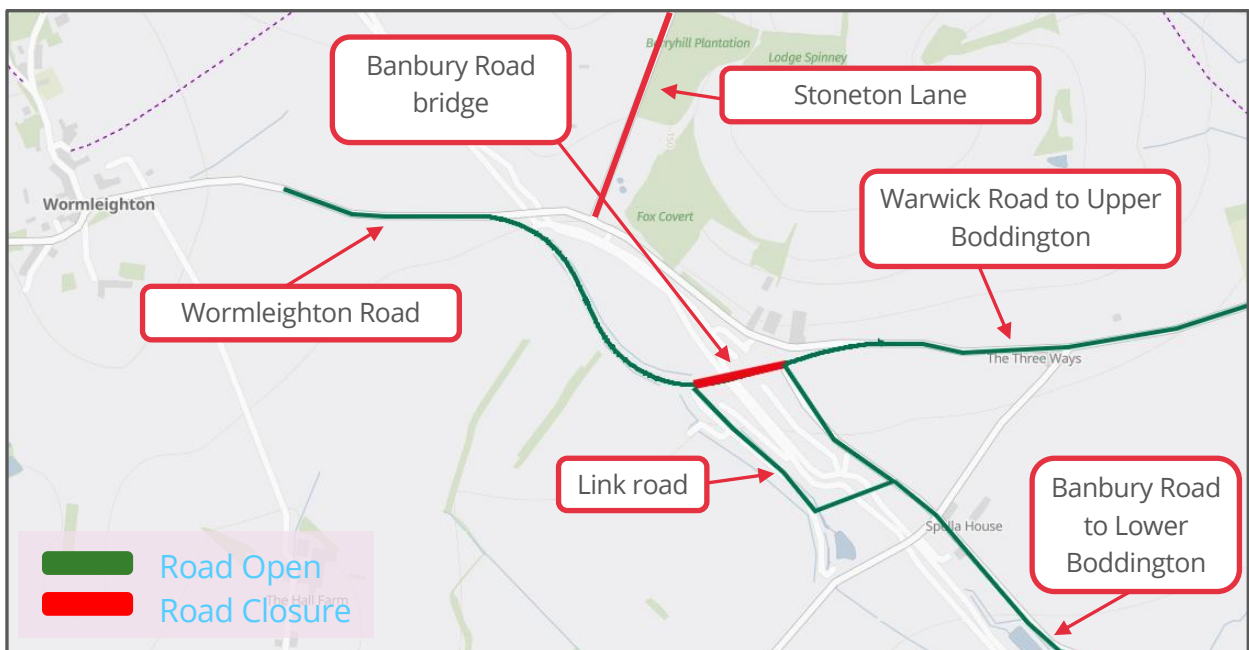

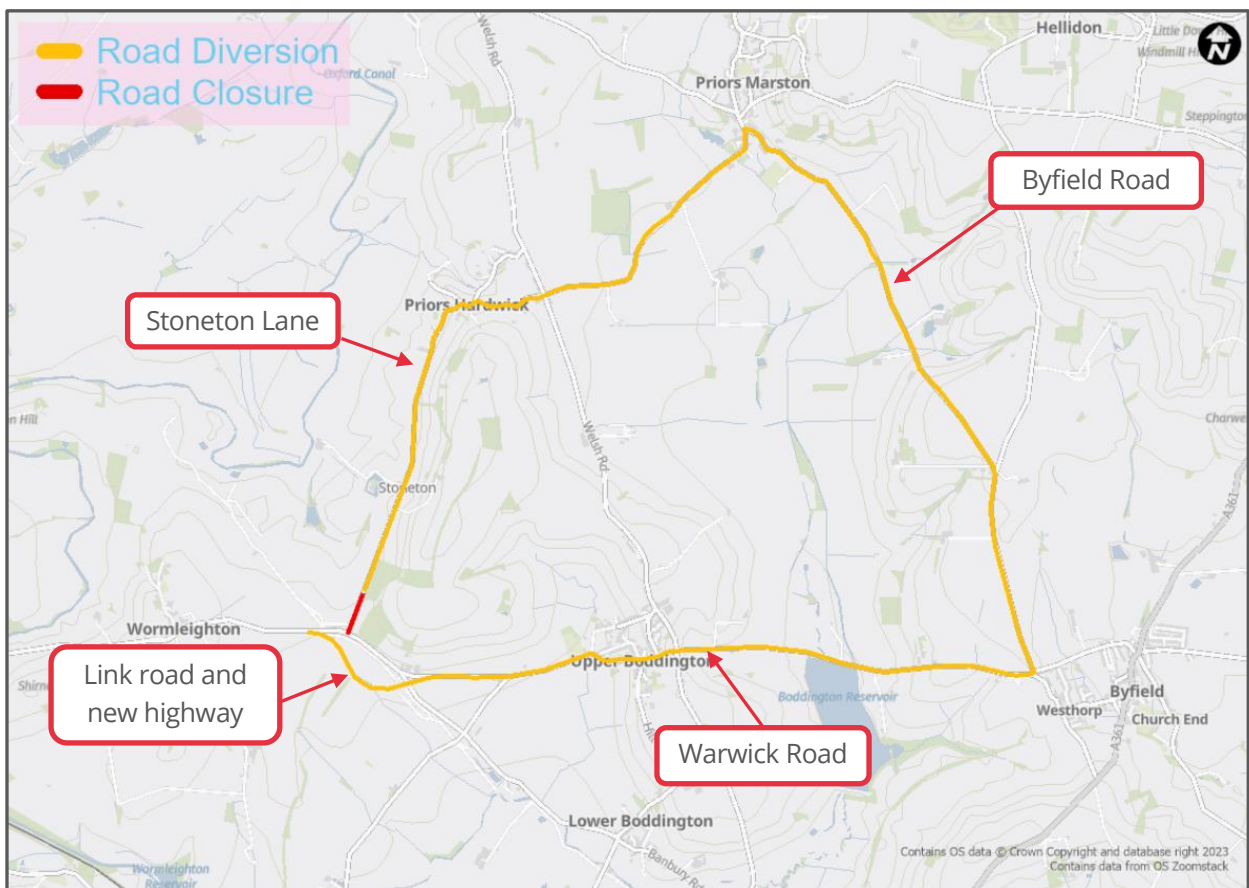
