



Weekend road closure on Victoria Road, North Acton

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

What are we doing

We wrote you in July about works to remove sections of the conveyor system in North Acton. We will start the next phase of works to remove the conveyor bridge over Victoria Road, between our Flat Iron and Atlas Road sites and next to the rail bridge.

This work will take place over the weekend of **Friday 3 to Monday 6 October 2025**.

If this work is delayed due to unforeseen circumstances such as poor weather, work may also take place on **Friday 10 to Monday 13 October** and **Friday 17 to Monday 20 October 2025**. We will update you if required.

How this will affect you

A section of Victoria Road will be closed between Chandos Road and Midland Terrace from **10pm Friday** to **5am Monday**. A signed diversion route will be in place.

We will safely remove the conveyor and lower it using a crane overnight from **10pm Saturday** to **5am Monday**. During this time there will be no footpath access below the rail bridge. A shuttle service will be available during this period, with marshals on site to assist the public. We'll write to local residents with further details about the shuttle service shortly.

During the works you may notice additional noise and lighting. We will brief our workers to be mindful of the community and continue to monitor our working methods to reduce disruption.

We apologise for any inconvenience this work may cause.

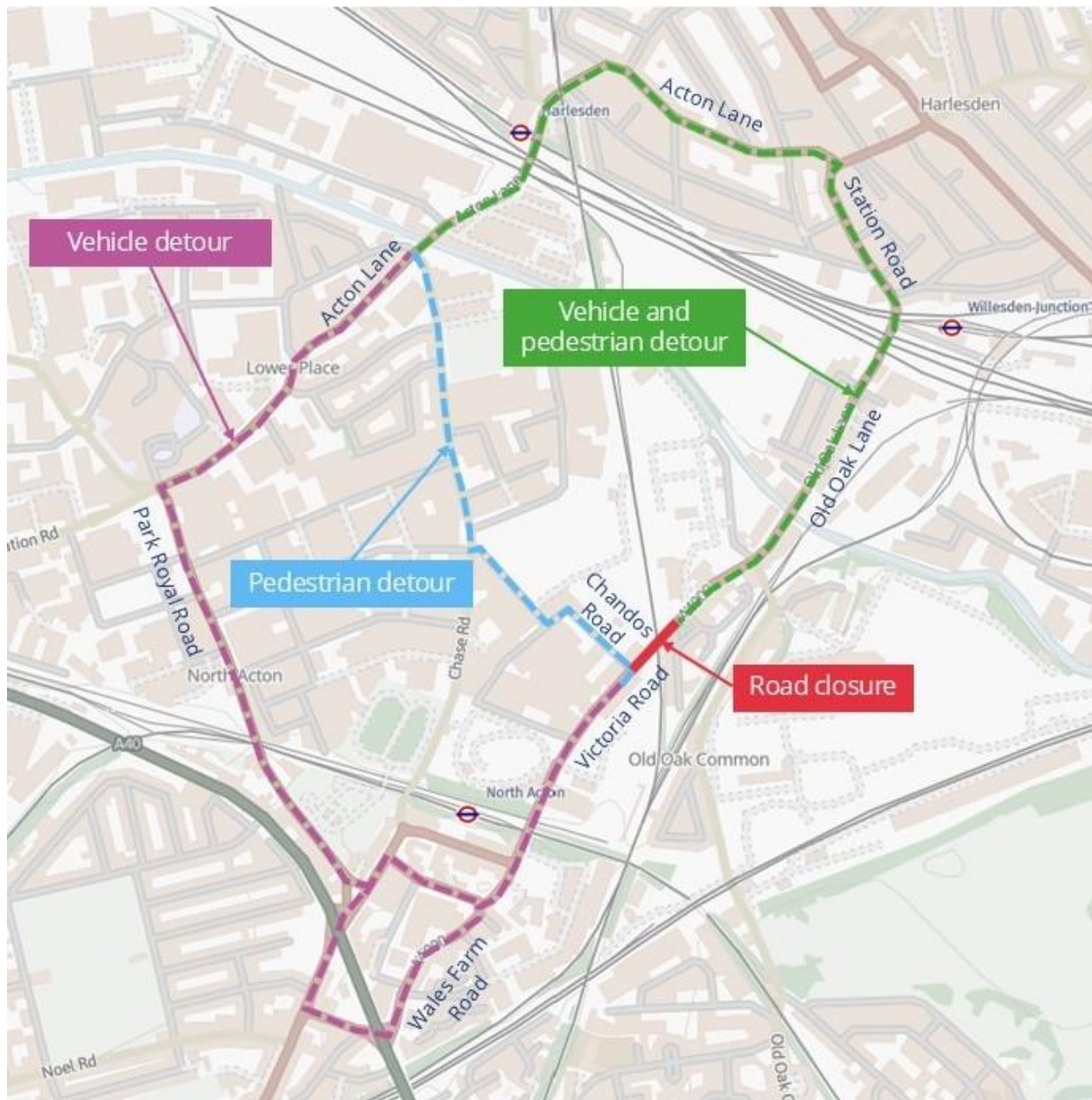

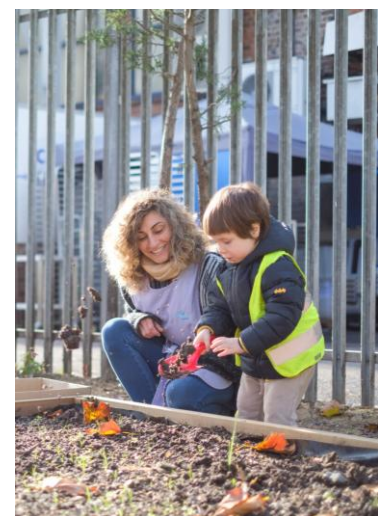
About our Community and Business Funds

We are offering two funds that are available to local communities and businesses between the West Midlands and London, to help with the disruption caused by our construction work. These are the Community and Environment Fund (CEF) and the Business and Local Economy Fund (BLEF).

The CEF is designed to give communities the opportunity to share in the benefits of HS2. It is an allocated fund that communities are able to apply for, to help to support local projects that aim to improve their local area.

The BLEF is designed to support local economies that may be disrupted by the construction of HS2. BLEF grants are for local business support organisations and local authorities to help maintain business activity in local communities.
