What we are doing

From **9pm on Sunday 28 September** to **5am on Monday 29 September**, we will be carrying out overnight surveys on Newyears Green Lane, at the junction with Breakspear Road South, in the area shown on the map overleaf.

The surveys will capture 3D information on road edges and tree trunk positions using Total station and GPS equipment. This data will help inform future design decisions in the area.

How these works will affect you

To allow the surveys to be carried out safely, a section of Newyears Green Lane at the junction with Breakspear Road South will be closed during the works.

The activity is expected to be completed in one overnight shift, between **9pm and 5am**, to minimise disruption to the local road network.

We would like to apologise in advance for any disruption or inconvenience this may cause. Every effort is being taken to ensure that these works are carried out in the least impactful way.
