High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

We are progressing works on the construction of the B4455 Fosse Way Cycle Bridge. While the new bridge is being constructed offsite, we will be excavating and preparing the area to support the crane that will be lifting the bridge into position, in early 2026. To carry out these works safely, we will need to close B4455 Fosse Way.

When will these works be taking place?

B4455 Fosse Way will be closed from **Monday 20 October until Sunday 2 November**. The road closure will be in place **24/7**. The Fosse Way will reopen 6pm on Sunday 2 November 2025.

What to expect

Access to properties, and for cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained throughout the works. You may notice increased levels of construction activity and some travel disruption. There will be a fully signed diversion in place to help drivers navigate their way. Please see the map on page two.




