High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

As we continue to progress construction of the Fosse Way Overbridge, we need to strengthen the Fosse Way to facilitate additional abnormal sized deliveries.

To allow us to safely complete all deliveries, we will build a temporary slab to protect the culvert located under the Fosse Way (B4455). Once all the deliveries are completed, the protection will be removed and the highway reinstated.

When will these works be taking place

The Fosse Way will be closed on the following dates:

Sunday 5 October 2025 from 6pm to 6am

Sunday 12 October 2025 from 12pm (midday) to 6am

Sunday 9 November 2025 from 12pm (midday) to 6am

What to expect

Access to properties, and for cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained throughout the works.

During the road closure a fully signposted diversion route will be in place, please see map on page two. You might experience some disruption to travel times, so please plan accordingly.

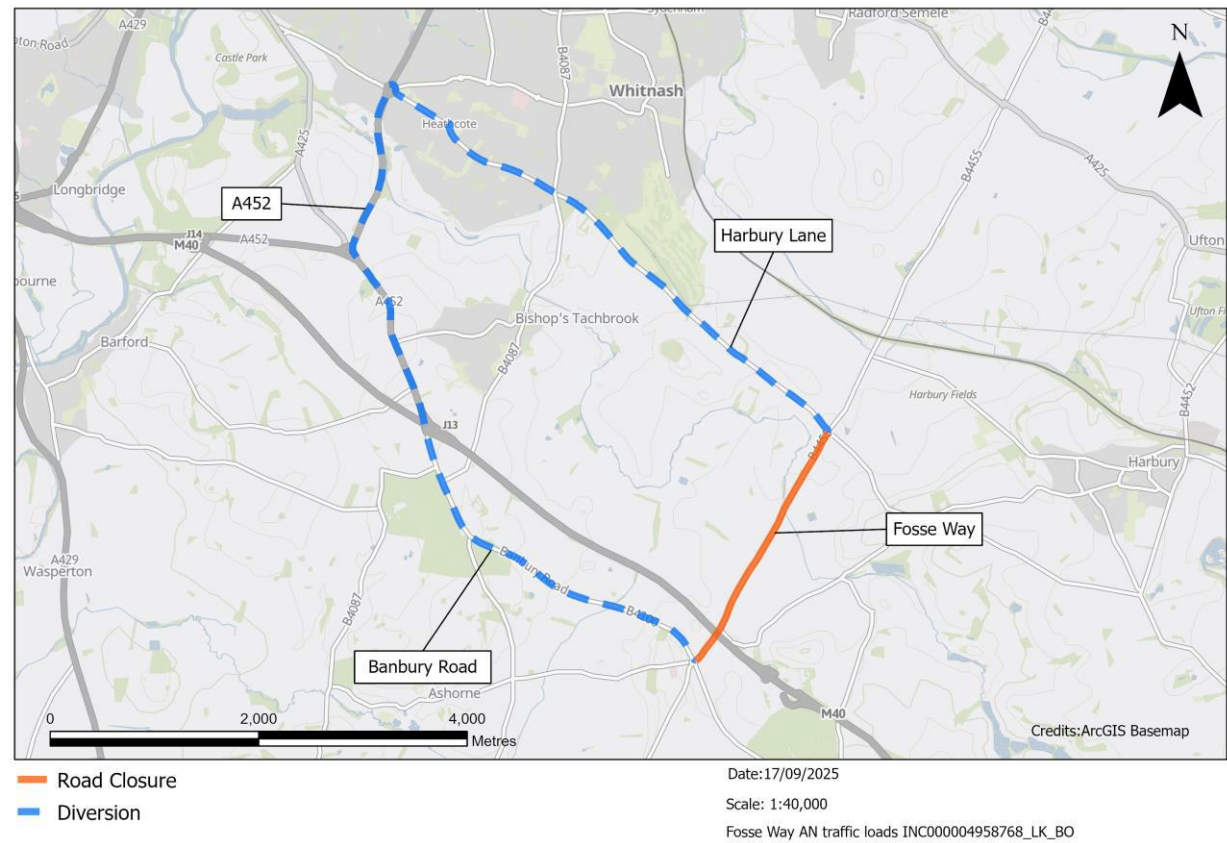

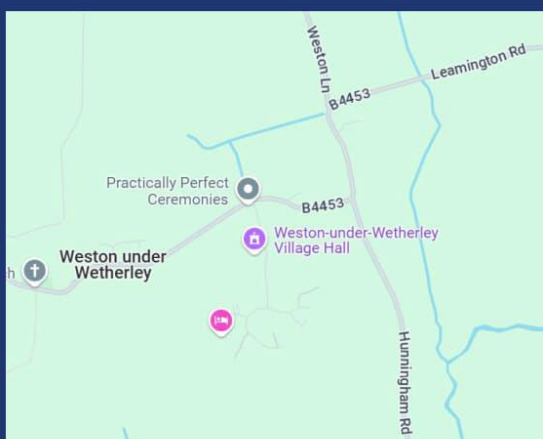
