



HS2 notice of temporary closure of Stareton Lane, Stoneleigh

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

As we progress construction works on the realignment of Stoneleigh Road and Stareton Lane, we will be constructing a new bellmouth access on Stareton Lane. This will provide a safe access and egress to our site. To facilitate this work we will install narrow lanes on Stareton Lane and a three day full road closure.

When these works will take place

The temporary narrow lane will be in place **from Monday 22 September to Friday 17 October 2025**. These will be in place **24/7**.

Daytime closures of Stareton Lane from **Wednesday 15 October to Friday 17 October 2025**. The closures will be in place **from 8am to 6pm**.

What to expect

During the narrow lane work you might experience minimal disruption to your journey time.

During the road closure, there will be a diversion route in place. Please see the map on page 2.

Temporary narrow lane from **Monday 22 September to Friday 17 October 2025**

Full road closure from **Wednesday 15 October to Friday 17 October 2025**

Full road closure between 8am – 6pm with diversion route

Our workforce may be on site one hour before and one hour after, to set up and secure our equipment

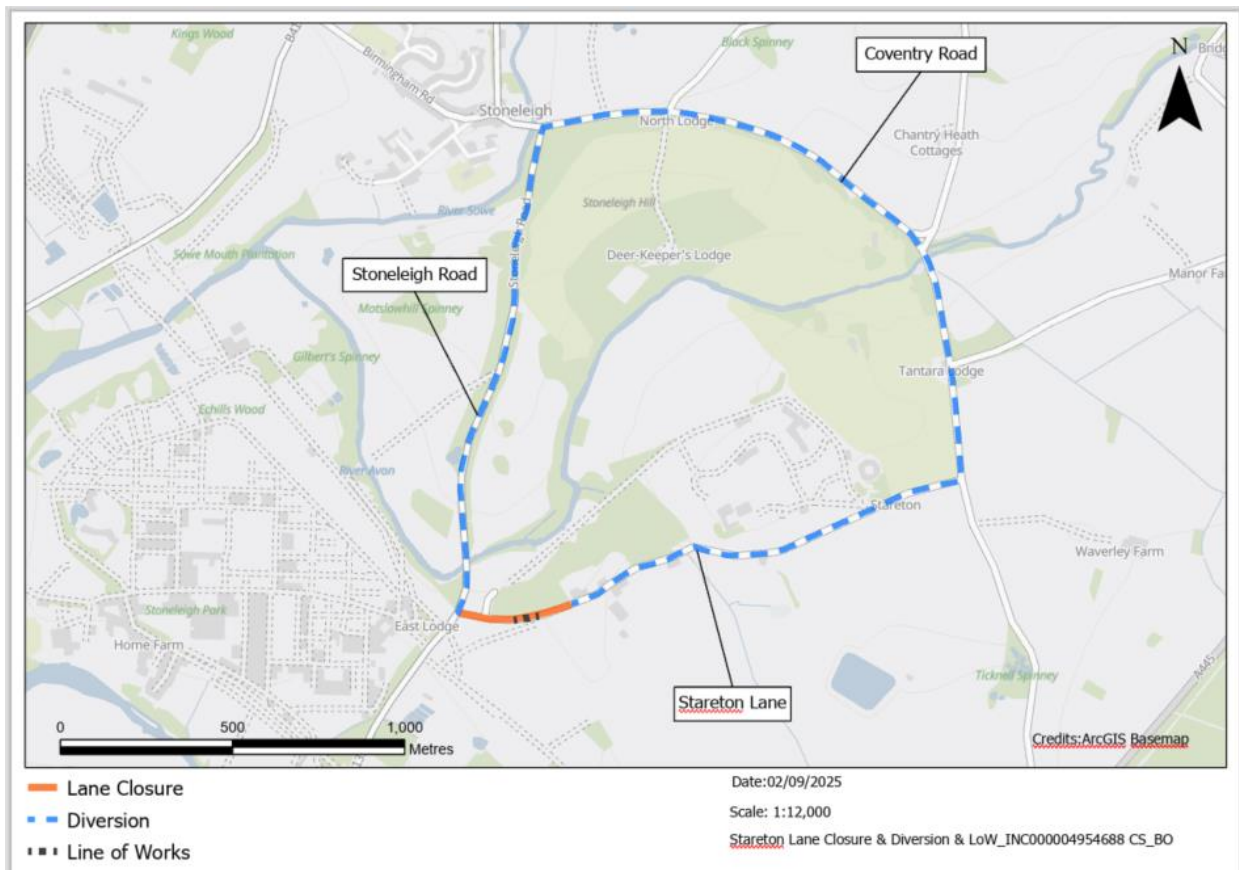
The diversion route
