The work we will be doing.

The new railway will pass under Lavender Hall Lane Overbridge which is currently in an advanced stage of construction. We are progressing works on the new road realignment which requires significant earthworks, utility and highway alterations to raise the existing road level by 10 metres. These works will be carried out under a long term closure in early 2026.

The prepare for these works we will undertake some vegetation clearance along Lavender Hall Lane.

When the work will take place

We will install daytime closures on Lavender Hall Lane from Monday 29 September to Friday 3 October 2025, between 9am and 3pm (please see the diversion route on page 2).

IMPORTANT

Under previous closures we have been able to escort pedestrians and cyclist safely through the closure. **Given the nature of the work, we are undertaking it will not be possible to do so this time.**

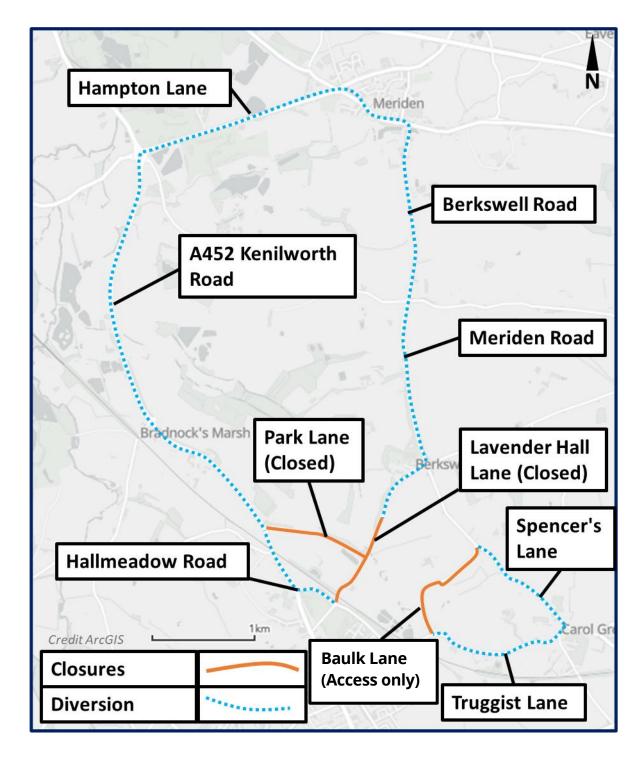
