Notice of A41 road closures and traffic management

What are we doing?

Reinstalling permanent traffic lights at A41/Station Road – in late October, permanent traffic lights will be reinstalled at the junction of the A41 Bicester Road and Station Road, near Waddesdon, replacing the current temporary traffic management in place.

New A41 Bicester Road signage – in October and November, we will be installing permanent road signage along the realigned A41 Bicester Road near Waddesdon and Fleet Marston.

A41 Bicester Road de vegetation – in late October, we will be removing two small trees alongside the existing A41 at the Fleet Marston temporary roundabout close to the EKFB compound. This is to allow realignment of underground utilities. There will be no impact to traffic.

When will these works take place?

Installing permanent traffic management - on Monday 27 October 9am to 1pm, 2-way temporary traffic management will be in place at A41 Bicester Road and Station Road.

New A41 Bicester Road signage installation – from Monday 27 October to Friday 7 November:

- Monday 27 October 8:30pm to 5:30am Friday 31 October full overnight closures new A41 Bicester Road (4 nights).
- Friday 31 October 8.30pm to 5:30am Saturday 1 November full overnight closure narrow Bicester Road (1 night)
- Monday 3 November 8:30pm to 5:30am Wednesday 5
 November full overnight closure narrow Bicester Road (2 nights)
- Wednesday 5 November 8:30pm to 5:30am Saturday 8
 November full overnight road closures on new A41Bicester Road (3 nights)


A41 Bicester Road De vegetation works

• Wednesday 29 October (9am to 3pm) – no traffic management or lane closure required.

Where will these works take place?

Installing permanent traffic management - there will be temporary traffic lights along the A41 Bicester Road and the junction with Station Road on **Monday 27 October (9am and 1pm),** as shown below:






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Where will these works take place?

Old Bicester Road - Friday 31 October to Saturday 1 November (1 night) and Monday 3 November to Wednesday 5 November (2 nights), 8.30pm to 5.30am, full overnight road closures along old Bicester Road between the junction with Waddesdon Hill and the new Waddesdon roundabout.





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Where will these works take place?

New A41 Bicester Road - Monday 27 October to Friday 31 October (4 nights) and Wednesday 5 November to Saturday 8 November (3 nights), 8.30pm to 5.30am, full overnight road closures along the new A41 Bicester Road between the Fleet Marston roundabout and Blackgrove Road Roundabout.






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Where will these works take place?

Wednesday 29 October - there will be de vegetation verge works along the A41 Bicester Road, **9am to 3pm**, no traffic management required, as shown below.
