# Notice of A46 overnight closures, near Kenilworth

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

# The work we are doing

We will complete the final safety, central reservation and utility work and then remove all the traffic management on the A46. While we deliver the works there will be increased construction activity overnight, some additional noise and ongoing lane closures. Once complete all lanes of the A46 will be open.

# When the work will take place

To ensure the safety of our workforce, we will be closing a section of the A46 from the Stivichall Interchange (Festival Island) to the Thickthorn Island (A452), and the southbound slip road at Stoneleigh on:

**8pm to 6am Friday 26 September,** the closure of two lanes northbound between Thickthorn and Stoneleigh, see map one.

**8pm to 6am Saturday 27,** the closure of the southbound slip onto the A46 at the Stoneleigh junction and the closure of two lanes between Festival Island and Thickthorn see map two.

Saturday 4, Sunday 5, Saturday 18 and on Sunday 19 October 8pm to 6am, a full closure of the A46 between Festival Island and Thickthorn Island. See maps three and four.

**8pm to 6am Monday 20 October,** the closure of the southbound slip at Stoneleigh and two lanes south between Stoneleigh and Thickthorn. See map two.





# Map 2: Southbound slip road

The southbound slip onto the A46 at the Stoneleigh junction, will be closed from 8pm to 6am on Saturday 27 September and on Monday 20 October from 8pm to 6am. Lane closures will be in place between the Stivichall Interchange (Festival Island) and Thickthorn on the southbound carriageway during the overnight closure.



Local traffic should use the following route: head north on the A46 to the Stivichall Interchange (Festival Island) and then head south to return on the A46 to continue your journey.




Overnight lane closures will be removed during the day to reduce the impact on the travelling public

# Map 3: Strategic diversion route (suitable for HGVs and through traffic)

During the overnight closures on Saturday 4, Sunday 5, Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 October between 8pm and 6am, the A46 will be closed in both directions between the Thickthorn Roundabout and Stivichall Interchange (Festival Island). All HGVs must follow the diversion route shown in the map below. HGVs travelling to Coventry and onwards to the north, please use the clearly signed diversion M40, M42, M6 east and then rejoin the A46. For HGVs travelling to Kenilworth, please leave at the Thickthorn Roundabout (A452). In addition to the black and yellow signs, there will be multiple electronic signs across the whole road network to help road users to navigate their way.






# Local diversion route

# **Map 4: Local diversion route**

During the overnight closures on Saturday 4, Sunday 5, Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 October between 8pm and 6am, the A46 will be closed in both directions between the Thickthorn Roundabout and Stivichall Interchange (Festival Island). Local traffic should follow the diversion route shown in the map below. For Kenilworth, please leave the A46 at the Thickthorn Roundabout. For northbound traffic and Coventry please leave the A46 at the Thickthorn Roundabout and travel along the A452, Bericote Road and Westhill Road, then use the A445 Leamington Road/ Leicester Lane and join the A423 towards Coventry and the A45 westbound to rejoin the A46. To travel south from Coventry please reverse the route.
