High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. EKFB is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at www.hs2innorthants.co.uk.

What are we doing?

Stoneton Lane will be closed, south of Priors Hardwick, for a minimum of two years while we build the Stoneton Lane green overbridge.

The design of the Stoneton Lane green overbridge includes a wide 'green' section of tree planting and vegetation. This will encourage local wildlife, including protected bat species, to cross the railway line safely.

Before work can begin on the bridge structure, we will excavate the railway line cutting. Due to the geology in the area, there will be a settlement period called 'heave' to allow the earth to stabilise.

A section of Stoneton Lane will be closed until the bridge is completed. Access to Priors Hardwick will be via alternative routes through Upper Boddington, or via Priors Marston and on towards Southam or Daventry.

When will these works take place?

From 26 August 2025 for approximately 2 years.


