

## Notice of traffic management, Banbury Road, Boddington

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. EKFB is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area. You can sign up for regular updates in your local area at [www.hs2innorthants.co.uk](http://www.hs2innorthants.co.uk).

### What are we doing?

As part of the works in the area we are moving a number of overhead utilities will be diverted away from the new railway line to a new location underground.

We will be working in the roadside verge on a section of Banbury Road between Lower Boddington and Wormleighton. To complete these activities safely, a section of single lane traffic, managed by traffic lights 24 hours a day, will be required.

We are aware of other road closures in the area and have coordinated these works to reduce additional disruption to local traffic.

### When will these works take place?

Monday 6 October 2025 to Sunday 16 November 2005.

The work is subject to changing weather condition and local authority consents and approvals.

Take care to respect the community.

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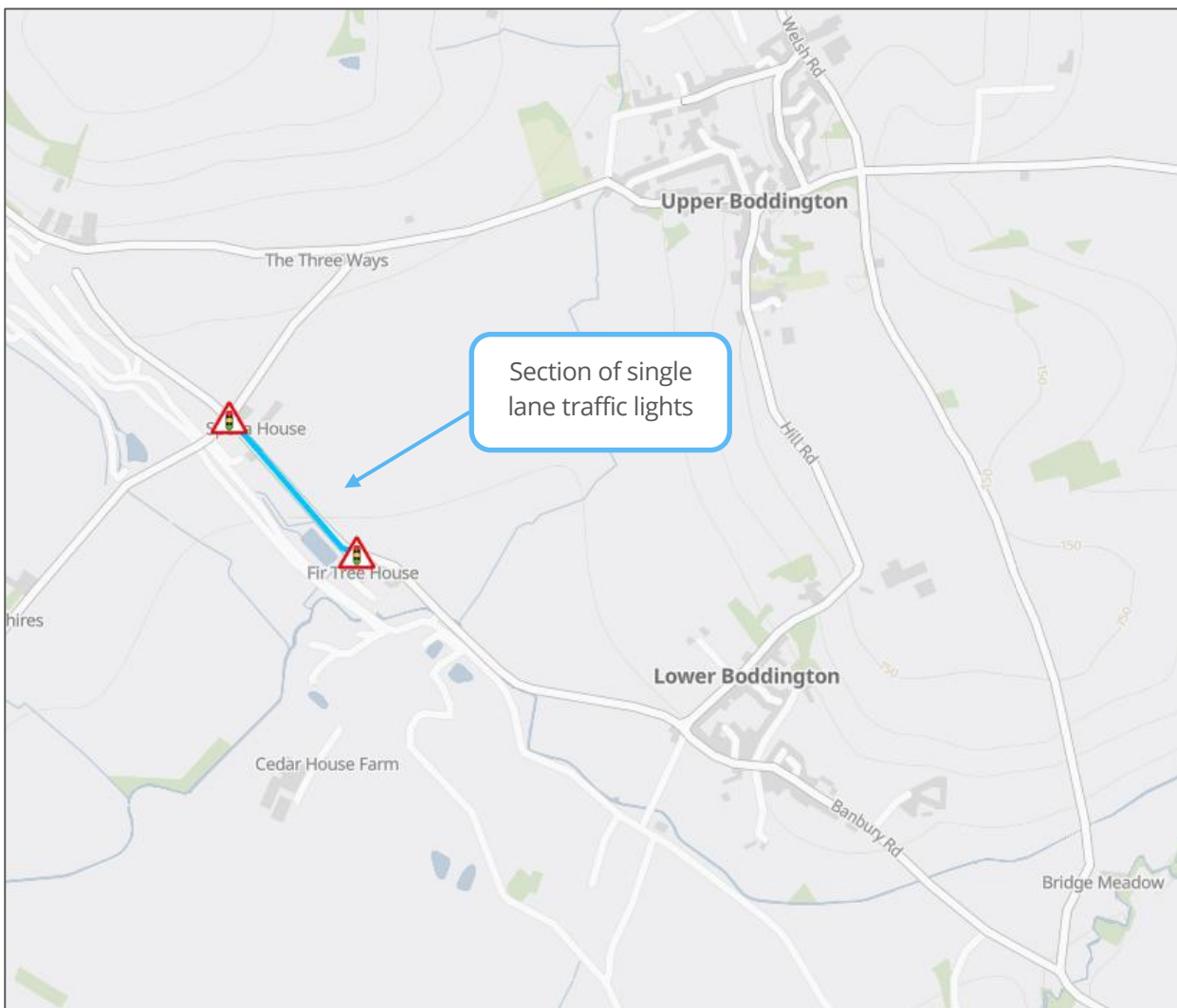
