What are we doing?

We will have two large tunnel segments delivered along the A413 for the construction of the Wendover Green Tunnel, overnight in mid October.

Due to the size of the precast tunnel segments (4.5m in width), they are classed as abnormal loads. These will be delivered to the Wendover bypass.

To safely deliver these tunnel segments, temporary overnight 3 and 2 way traffic management on the A413 will be set up at the Railway bridge and Small Dean Viaduct. The abnormal load delivery route is shown in the map below.

When will these works take place?

The abnormal loads will be completed overnight from Tuesday 14 October to Wednesday15th October, from 8.30pm to 5.30am. Associated temporary traffic management, will in place as shown below:

- A413 Railway bridge with 3 way traffic lights
- A413 Small Dean Viaduct with 2 way traffic lights

A delivery is made subject to road and weather conditions.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control but will be completed on or around the timings specified.

Duration of works

Overnight abnormal load deliveries from 14 October -15 October 2025, 8:30pm to 5:30am.

What to expect

Off-peak temporary 3 and 2 way traffic management for the delivery of the Wendover Green Tunnel segments.

Abnormal loads will normally be delivered subject to normal road and weather conditions.

What we will do

Respond promptly to any complaints we may receive and action accordingly.

Manage any noise or traffic impacts.

What route will be used to deliver the Wendover Green Tunnel segments?

The prescast tunnel segments will be delivered via the M40, where they will exit at Junction 2 Beaconsfield, for the A355 heading north. They will then contunue their journey north on the A413 to be delivered to the Wendover bypass.

The map below shows the delivery route and location of the temporary traffic management:
