These works are to help us prepare the realignment on the northern section of Old Oak Common Lane, as well as facilitating future tunnel connections and continuing with critical utility works.

Sewer works:

As part of our station enabling works, we need to connect the tunnelling from our HS2 SCS site to Old Oak Common. There is a waste sewer pipe that runs up and down Old Oak Common Lane. To future proof this pipe for these works, we need to line the sewer to protect it when the tunnelling works commence.

There will be no impact on residential water or waste services during any of these works. Access for Wells House Road residents and visitors will be maintained throughout. See map below.

Tie-in for the northern realignment:

To help us construct the northern realignment on Old Oak Common Lane, there'll be a weekend when Old Oak Common Lane will be closed to allow new and existing stretches of road to be connected. Work over this weekend will include plaining out the road (with a machine like a combine harvester), realigning tarmac, lining the road and utility connections. A second weekend closure will follow early in the new year and we'll share details soon.
