Notice of road closure **Hunningham Road, near** Offchurch

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

As we continue to progress with the permanent realignment of Hunningham Road, we will be closing the road in two phases to complete the next stages of the realignment of the road. In addition to the highway work, there will be a number of utility connections completed to join the diverted services to the existing utilities.

When these works will take place

These works will take place from:

Phase one: Monday 3 November - Saturday 29 November 2025. Phase two: Monday 9 February - Saturday 7 March 2026.

The closure will be in place **24/7**.

What to you will expect

You may notice increased construction activity with some travel disruptions to your journey. There will be a signed diversion route in place during the closure, please plan your journey ahead. See page two for map information.

Access to all properties, for cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained throughout the closure.

The Hunningham Road closure will be in place 24/7

Phase one: Monday 3 **November - Saturday** 29 November 2025

Phase two: Monday 9 February - Saturday 7 March 2026


