Following the re-alignment of Welsh Road earlier in the year, BBV need to carry out a CCTV survey of the new drainage system ready to hand over the road to the local highway authority. To carry out these works safely, we will need overnight closures of Welsh Road.

When will these works be taking place

Welsh Road overnight closures will be in place from **Monday 27 October to Friday 31 October 2025, between 8.00pm and 6.00am.**The road will reopen on the morning of Saturday 1 November 2025.

What to expect

Access to properties, and for cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained throughout the works. You may notice increased construction activity along the public highway with some travel disruptions to your journey. Please allow enough time for journeys. A fully signed diversion will be in place. 


