
Notice of temporary traffic lights and overnight road closure on A425 Leamington Road, Southam

The work we will be doing

As we continue to progress the construction of the Long Itchington Green Tunnel, we will need to clear some vegetation, complete a number of trial holes in preparation for the new realignment of the A425 Leamington Road. We will also be repairing part of the carriageway near a Severn Trent water main. To carry out the works in a safe and secure environment, we will need temporary traffic lights and an overnight closure on the A425 near the Dallas Burston Pollo Club.

When will these works be taking place?

The **temporary traffic lights** will be in place on **Tuesday 18** and **Wednesday 19 November 2025, 8am to 6pm.**

The **overnight closure** will be in place on **Thursday 4 December 2025**, **from 8pm to 6am**.

What to expect

Access for cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained throughout the works. You may notice increased levels of construction activity and some travel disruption. There will be a fully signed diversion in place to help drivers navigate their way. Please see the map on page two.


