Various site activities including but not limited to: reinforce concrete wall installation; cable diversion and headhouse construction; concrete pour and base slab install

You may experience some noise from crane movement and site activities. There will be overnight works in the shaft, and site lighting will be visible at surface level.

We will use noise reducing barriers, and damp down dust where possible.

We do not expect these works to be disruptive.



Working hours: 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday, 8am to 1pm Saturdays. On some Saturdays we may work extended hours until 6pm	
Ongoing until 3 March 2026	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cable diversion works on Mandeville Road until 3 February 2026 and Badminton Close We are demolishing three garages and building a new site entrance on Badminton Close
Ongoing until summer 2026	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are continuing to build the headhouse. These works include ground excavations, breaking concrete and building reinforced concrete walls
Working hours: 6am to 10pm, Monday to Friday	
Six days in both February and March 2026	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Concrete pours for headhouse base slab There will be deliveries to site from 4am Concrete pours will start at 6am and will finish before 10pm
