High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

A new high-speed railway station is being built within Solihull, near the M42, A45 Coventry Road and A446 Stonebridge Road, close to the NEC, Birmingham Business Park and Birmingham Airport.

As part of our ongoing programme of works to upgrade the local highway network in preparation for HS2, we will be carrying out the installation of lamp columns and undertaking CCTV surveys.

To ensure the safety of the public and our workforce, these works will be carried out overnight under lane closures.

Overnight lane closures:

Each night from 8pm Monday 27 October until 6am Saturday 1 November 2025.


