What are we doing?

As part of our preparatory works and for the safety of the public, we have previously closed some Public Rights of Way (PRoW) in the Calvert area.

The currently closed QUA/36/1, which is located to the west of Finemere woods, requires an extension in length to facilitate the construction of drainage systems and associated pipework.

A section of the footpath, QUA/37/1, which connects to QUA/36/1 from the south, also requires a temporary closure. This is necessary to provide the team with a safe working area to demolish the existing bridge, GUA1, and complete essential drainage works. The map overleaf shows the location of these footpaths.

When will these works take place?

This section of Public Rights of Way known as QUA/36/1 and QUA/37/1, will be closed from 6 October 2025 – 31 May 2026.

Duration of works

A section of both QUA/36/1 and QUA/37/1 will be closed until 31 May 2026.

What to expect

Appropriate signage will be places in advance of the closures along these PRoW's, detailing the closure durations.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

Take care to respect the community.

Install and maintain local signs to inform people of temporary closures and diversions.


Notice of Closure of Public Rights of Way, QUA/36/1 and QUA/37/1, Calvert
