What are we doing?

Towards the end of October there will be 3-way temporary traffic lights in place on Gawcott Road, Calvert. These will be in place to facilitate the Anglian Water asset connection to the existing pipe, including excavation, pipe and valve installation, backfilling and compaction.

When will these works take place?

The traffic management will be in place from Thursday 23 October to Friday 31 October 2025.

These dates may be subject to change due to circumstances outside of our control, such as weather.

Duration of works

A section of Gawcott Road, near the entrance of the EKFB compound will be under temporary traffic management in the form of 3-way temporary traffic lights from:-

Thursday 23 October until Friday 31 October 2025.


