What are we doing?

There will be traffic management in the form of 3-way temporary traffic lights on Addison Road to carry out some repairs to the footpath.

In addition, there are some works to be carried out on the expansion joints on Addison Road bridge and this will necessitate a full closure.

During these dates the bridge will be closed to carry out repairs to the expansion joints from Saturday 8 November at 7.30am and will reopen 9.00am on Monday 10 November.

When will these works take place?

Addison Road will have a lane closure with temporary traffic lights from 3 November to 17 November 2025.

There will also be a full road closure 8 and 9 November 2025. This will take place from 07.30am Saturday 8 November and will reopen at 09.00am on Monday 10 November 2025.

These dates may change due to conditions outside of our control, such as weather. Please refer to the HS2 website regularly to check for any changes and updates.

Duration of works

Addison Road will have temporary traffic lights from 3 November to 17 November 2025 and will also be fully closed on the weekend of 8- 9 November 2025.

Normal working hours: Monday to Friday 8am-6pm Saturdays 8am-1pm

Please note there will be an hour set up and close down either side of the above hours.

What to expect

A rolling set of temporary traffic lights will moving, in phases, along Addison Road towards School Hill.

A full road closure 8 November to 10 November 2025.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.


