What are we doing?

In September a new section of road opened between Wormleighton and Boddington. Following a period of use, we have carried out further observations and inspections and as a result will be making some amendments.

To complete these works safely a section of Wormleighton Road, Banbury Road and Warwick Road will be closed for one weekend.

When will these works take place?

From 8pm on Friday 7 November to 6am Monday 10 November.

These works are subject to local authority consents and approvals.

Take care to respect the community.

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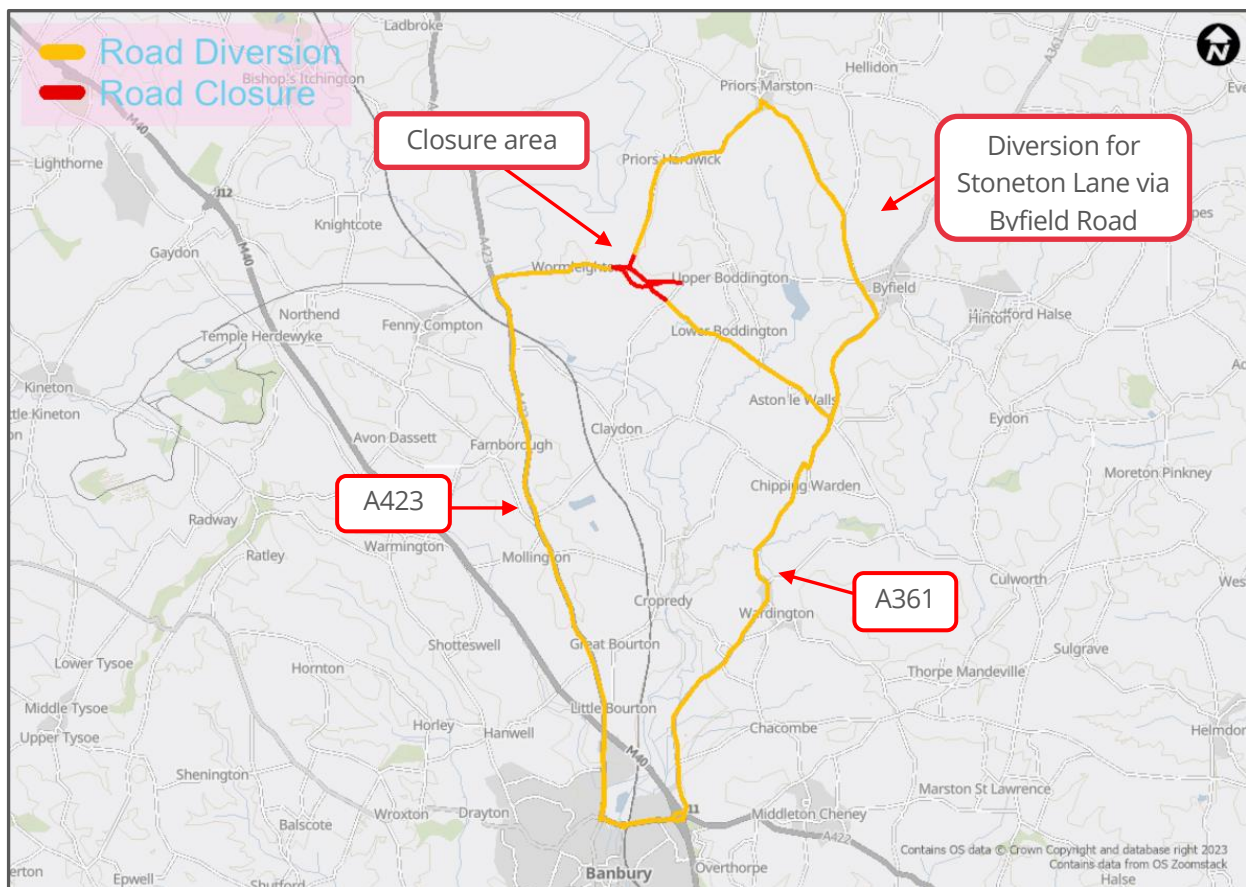
