High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

What are we doing

We will be removing monitoring equipment installed on railway bridges on Station Approach and West End Road in South Ruislip. These monitors are no longer required as the tunnelling works in the area are now complete.

These works will be carried out over the following dates and times:

Station Approach

4 and 5 November 2025, overnight from 10pm to 5am

West End Road

11 and 12 November 2025, overnight from 10pm to 5am

How this may affect you

We need to temporarily close a lane and footpath during each shift to safely carry out the works.

We will use temporary traffic lights to guide traffic.

A pedestrian diversion will be in place.





The maps below show the location of the works






Overnight lane closures on Station Approach and West End Road, Hillingdon


